


Requires three "AA" (LR6) **alkaline** batteries (not included).

Adult assembly is required.

Tool required for battery installation: Phillips screwdriver (not included).

Wipe this toy with a clean, damp cloth.



We recommend the use of alkaline batteries for longer battery life.

#### **Battery Installation**

- Locate the battery compartment door on the bottom of the lighthouse.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three "AA" (LR6) alkaline batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw with a Phillips screwdriver.
   Do not over-tighten.
- When sounds or lights from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.




### **Battery Safety Information**


Batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your toy. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the toy. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in a fire. The batteries may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.


# Assembly

## Fun at the Lighthouse!



Use the crane to load the cargo.



Use the pump to fill up the tugboat.



Press the button on top to turn on the light and hear fun sound effects.



When a train travels through the harbor tunnel next to the lighthouse, you'll also get lights and sound effects (train not included).

**Hint:** If a train does not pass through the tunnel for a few minutes, the lighthouse turns off automatically. Press the top button on the lighthouse to turn the toy back on.

Important: The lighthouse automatic sounds and lights feature is activated by contrast in lighting. This feature may not work if the toy is in very bright light or direct sunlight. Please keep the lighthouse out of bright light or direct sunlight.
