


Place ON/OFF switch in ON position to allow activation of the toy. The switch is located on the bottom of the skate.




REQUIRED TOOL:


"Sleep" mode: If your toy shuts off during play, squeeze its left hand to start it up again.

The toy has 2 modes of play: "forwards/backwards" and "found and round". The toy can be changed from the "forwards/backwards" mode to the "round and round" mode, and vice versa, by moving the switch located on the bottom of the right skate.



3 Use the backpack remote control to make Mickey skate forward, backward, forward round and round, and backward round and round.

Mickey and Minnie can play together! The color of each toy's helmet determines which other toy it can be played with. See chart for details on the variety of play options.


Red helmet Mickey can play with Pink helmet Minnie 27 MHz

Yellow helmet Mickey can play with Yellow helmet Minnie 27 MHz 49 MHz


Red belimet Mickey can play with Yellow belimet Mickey 44 MHz 27 MHz

(4) To replace batteries: (A) Unscrew battery door on the backpack using a Phillips head screwdriver (not included). Lift off battery door and insert 9V battery. (B) Unscrew battery doors on each skate using a Phillips head screwdriver (not included). Lift off battery dopr and insert two "AA" alkaline batteries in each skate.
