



# Decorate with markers & cool stampers again & again!

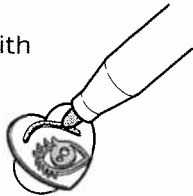

With the doll not wearing a wig, place the mask on doll's face.



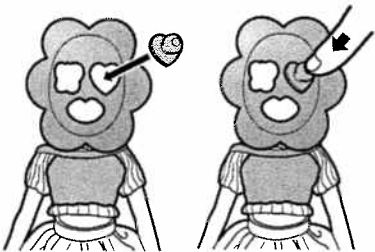

Color a stamper with a marker. Stamp quickly so the ink does not dry out on the stamper.



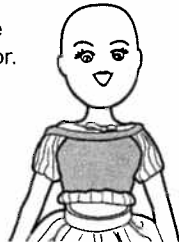

Press the stamper through the corresponding shaped opening in the mask.

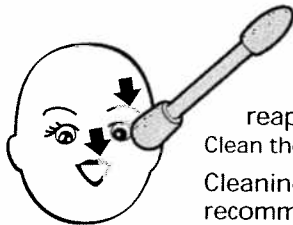
Create an *outline* by stamping the eyes and mouth on your doll's face. Finish by coloring in the outlines! Clean stamper thoroughly before applying a new color.



**Use only What's Her Face™ markers on this product.**

Dampen the sponge applicator with water to erase your doll's face.



Completely wipe the face clean with the sponge applicator. Dry the face before reapplying. Clean the applicator afterwards if necessary. Cleaning the doll before storage is recommended.

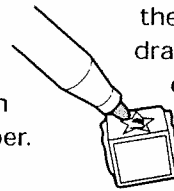
## There are 3 ways to play...

1. Use the mask with the stampers, as shown.
2. Use the stampers without the mask.
3. Draw freehand with no mask or stampers, just using the pens.

## Decorate your doll's clothes too

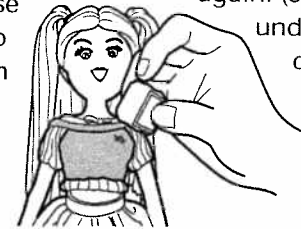
Color a stamper with a marker. Stamp quickly so the ink does not dry out on the stamper.

Press the stamper on the doll's clothes.

You can also use the markers to draw your own designs on the doll's clothes.

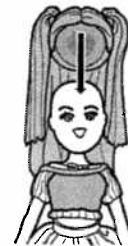
Wash off markers to decorate again and again. (See step 5 under the face decorating section.)

**Always re-cap your marker when not in use.**

**If your marker does become dry, you can reactivate it by dipping the marker into warm water for a few minutes.**

## Your doll's wig

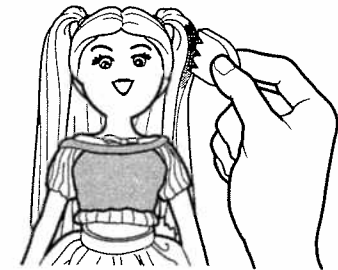
Attach the wig's fabric fastener to the matching piece of fabric fastener on the doll's head.



## Streaking doll's wig

Dip the sponge applicator in cold water. Apply the wet sponge to the wig's streaks. It changes color!

*Only the streaks in the hair will change color.* Use warm water to change back to original color.
