


# **Battery Replacement**



For best performance, we recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with three, new **alkaline** batteries.

#### **Battery Tips**

- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Remove the batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the toy. Battery leakage and corrosion can damage this toy. Dispose of batteries safely.
- Never short circuit the battery terminals.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended in the "Battery Replacement" instructions are to be used.
- If removable rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before they are charged.
- If you use a battery charger, it should be examined regularly for damage to the cord, plug, enclosure and other parts. Do not use a damaged battery charger until it has been properly repaired.



- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. (The screw will remain in the door.)
- Lift to remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three "AA" (LR6) **alkaline** batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.


**Helpful Hint:** We recommend using alkaline batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- When sounds from this toy become faint or stop working, it's time for an adult to replace the batteries!

# Let's Listen and Learn

The Jivin' Jukebox™ has two modes: Numbers and Letters and Colors and Shapes.

#### **Numbers and Letters Mode**




• To learn numbers and letters, slide the mode switch to the top position  $^{\text{AC}}_{12\text{y}}$  .

**Buttons** 

- Press any of the number keys to hear a number as well as short song and dancing lights.
- Press any of the letter keys to hear a letter as well as short song and dancing lights.
- Spin the roller to hear a friendly tune. Lights flash as the music plays!
- To turn the Jivin' Jukebox™ off, slide the mode switch to the middle position • .


### **Colors and Shapes Mode**



- To learn colors and shapes, slide the mode switch to the bottom position .
- Press any of the shape keys to hear a shape as well as short song and dancing lights.
- Press any of the color keys to hear a color as well as short song and dancing lights.
- Spin the roller to hear a friendly tune. Lights flash as the music plays!
- To turn the Jivin' Jukebox™ off, slide the mode switch to the middle position .

- Locate the volume switch on the back of the toy.
