




## 

- Do not launch the rescue buoys at point blank range.
- Only use the projectiles (rescue buoys) supplied with this toy. Do not fire at people or animals.





- Position the arch with the bend toward the back of the pontoon boat. Insert and snap the arch tabs into the slots in the pontoon boat.
- Position the handle with the smooth side toward the front of the jet ski. At an angle, fit a knob on the end of the handle into one of the slots in the jet ski.
  Snap the other knob on the end of the handle into the other slot in the jet ski.



• For best results, avoid applying the labels more than once.

One-time assembly is now complete.
