- Before assembling the BARBIE™ Party Playhouse, please wipe each part with a clean, dry cloth.




- · Locate the front door, rear wall and stove top.
- Make sure the areas where the labels will be applied are clean and dry.
- · Apply the labels as indicated in the illustration.
- For best adhesion, try to avoid applying the labels more than once.




- · Stand the rear wall upright with the inside facing you.
- Position the table over the rear wall, with the curved side outward.
- Fit the "L" shaped tabs on the rear wall into the slots in the table.




Firmly slide the table to the right to secure it in place.




- Fit the square peg on the underside of the stove top into the square "hole" in the table.
- Insert two 17/2" screws through the underside of the table and into the stove top. Tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.




- Fit the table support under the table and onto the outside of the rear wall.
- Insert two 1'/4" screws through the table support and into the table. Tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- Insert two 1³/₉" screws with washers through the table support and into the rear wall. Tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.



- · Position the threshold on a flat surface, as shown.
- Position the left front wall so that the inside is facing up. **Helpful Hint:** The parts have been labeled as if you are looking at the front of the product completely assembled.
- · Fit the left front wall onto the threshold, as shown.
- Insert three 11/2" screws into the left front wall and tighten with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.




- Position the right front wall so that the inside is facing up. Helpful Hint: The parts have been labeled as if you are looking at the front of the product completely assembled.
- · Fit the right front wall onto the threshold, as shown.
- Insert three 1½" screws into the right front wall and tighten with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.



 Position the right side wall so that the inside is toward the front wall assembly.

Helpful Hint: The parts have been labeled as if you are looking at the front of the product completely assembled.


 Insert and snap the right side wall tabs into the slots in the front wall assembly.



 Position the left side wall with molded in table detail (on inside) so that the outside is facing you.



 Insert and snap the left side wall tabs into the slots in the front wall assembly.




- Position the rear wall so that the table is upward.
- Align the three tabs on the right and left side walls with the three slots in each side of the rear wall.
- Push down near the three slots on each side of the rear wall to snap it into place.




- · Turn the playhouse assembly upright, as shown.
- Push the right rear corner of the playhouse assembly so that the walls do not form a square.
- · Position the corner chair so that the tabs are downward.
- Fit the corner chair into the front and left side walls, as shown.



 Reposition the walls so that they form a square, as shown. This will lock the corner chair in place.




Rotate the patio doors closed.




 Insert the peg on the left patio door into the hole in the rear wall.

Helpful Hint: The parts have been labeled as if you are looking at the front of the product completely assembled.


 Insert the peg on the right patio door into the hole in the rear wall.




 Insert the door knob into the hole in the front side of the front door.




- Lay the front door down so that the door knob is on a flat surface.
- Push on the front door, near the door knob, to snap the door knob completely into the hole.




- · Place the roof onto a flat surface.
- · Fit the canopy into the groove on the roof.



- Position the front door so that the door knob is outward.
- At an angle, insert the peg on the front door into the hole in the threshold.
- Rotate the front door up.




- While holding the canopy onto the roof, tip the roof on its side.
- Insert two 11/2" screws into the roof and tighten with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.




 Position the roof over the playhouse so that the canopy is over the table.




 Align the peg on the front door and the tab on the front wall with the holes in the roof at the front right corner.
 Push down on the roof to secure it in place.




 Align the tabs on the playhouse with the holes in the roof at the front left corner. Push down on the roof to secure it in place.




 Align the post on the patio door and the tabs on the playhouse with the holes in the roof at the rear right corner. Push down on the roof to secure it in place.




 Align the post on the patio door and the tabs on the playhouse with the holes in the roof at the rear left corner. Push down on the roof to secure it in place.




 While holding the sink upside down, insert and snap a faucet knob, the faucet and the other faucet knob (in this order) into the holes in the top side of the sink.



- · Turn the sink upside down.
- · Fit the sink retainer into the rectangular recess in the sink.




• Fit the sink into the rectangular opening in the table. Helpful Hint: The sink can be filled with water for real clean-up fun and can be removed to drain.




 Fit the telephone receiver into the telephone cradle inside the playhouse, near the sink.

Assembly is now complete.


Disassembly for Storage



- · Locate a tab in any of the inside corners of the playhouse.
- Slide and insert a large slotted screwdriver between the roof and the tab on the inside of the playhouse.
- While rotating the screwdriver toward the wall, lift the corner of the roof off of the playhouse.
- Repeat this procedure to unlatch the roof from the other three corners of the playhouse.
- · Remove the roof.
- · Remove the front door and the patio doors.
- · Remove the sink and telephone receiver.
- · Remove the corner chair.



- Tip the playhouse on its side.
- Push down on one of the corners. The playhouse will disassemble into two pieces.



- Push down on the left and right side walls to disassemble the playhouse into four pieces.
- Store all parts of the BARBIE™ Party Playhouse, including the hardware and this instruction booklet in a safe place for future re-assembly.

Maintenance

- Periodically inspect the BARBIE™ Party Playhouse for wear or damage and tighten the screws as needed.
- To clean, wash the BARBIET Party Playhouse with a mild scap and water solution and a soft cloth. Rinse the BARBIET Party Playhouse with water to remove scap residue.
