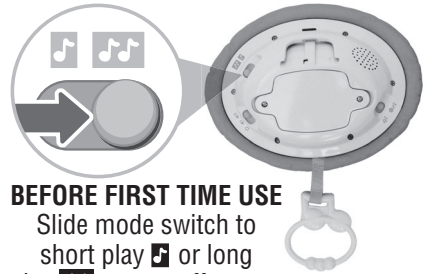

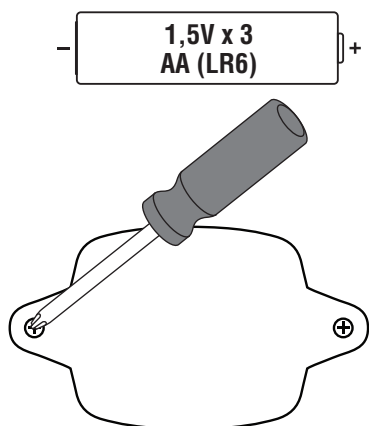

Battery Replacement



Battery Safety Information

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
 - Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
 - Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
 - Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
 - Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
 - Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
 - Remove rechargeable batteries from the product before charging.
 - If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

- For longer life, use **alkaline** batteries.
 - Locate the battery compartment door on the music and lights toy.
 - Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver and remove the door.
 - Remove the exhausted batteries and dispose of them properly.
 - Insert three AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.
 - Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws. Do not over-tighten.
 - If the music and lights toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power/volume switch off and back on.
 - When sounds or lights become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.

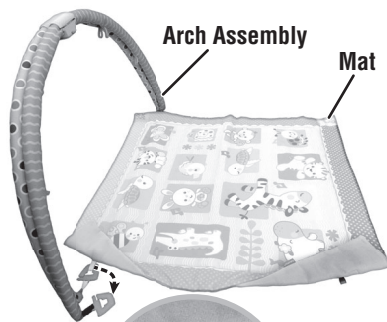

Arch Assembly with Mat

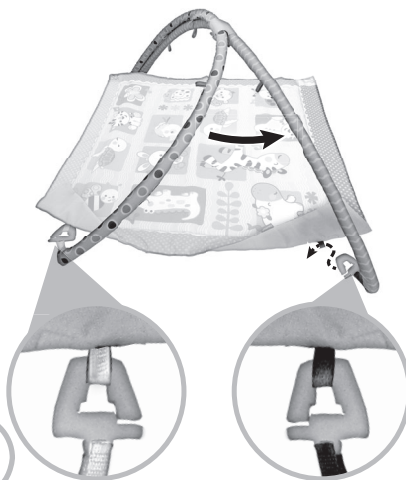

- Locate the hooks and loops underneath the mat. The hook straps and the loops are different colors. When properly assembled, the hook strap color will match the loop color.
- While holding the end of an arch, carefully unfasten the hook with the strap that does not match the loop.

- Next, fasten the hook with strap that matches the color of the loop on the other end of the mat.
- Repeat this procedure to assemble the hooks to the loops on the other side of the mat.

- Slide and **“snap”** the music and lights toy onto the arch assembly hub.

- **To remove the music and lights toy and use on-the-go:** Slide the latch on the arch assembly connector and lift to remove the music and lights toy.

Storage and Care

- Unfasten the hooks of one of the arches and fold the arches together.

- Fasten the hooks to the loops on the other end of the mat (on both sides).

Care

- The mat, parrot, monkey and zebra toys are machine washable. Remove the arch assembly from the mat. Machine wash cold on the gentle cycle. Do not use bleach. Tumble dry on low heat.
- The arch assembly, hard toys and music and lights toy are surface washable only. Wipe with a clean cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution. Do not immerse.

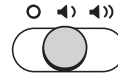


Hang the link on each toy to any of the loops around the gym.

Power/Volume Switch



Music Select Switch



Mode Switch

- Slide the power/volume switch to ON with low volume , ON with high volume  or OFF .
- Slide the music select switch to:
 -  Instrumental Music
 -  Sung Songs

- Slide the mode switch to:

 **Short Play** - Tap or shake the music and lights toy for a short tune and dancing lights.

 **Long Play** - Pull the toy on the music and lights toy for up to 30 minutes of music and a light show (only if you select Instrumental Music .
