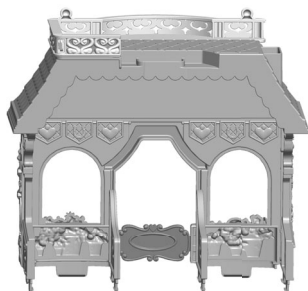

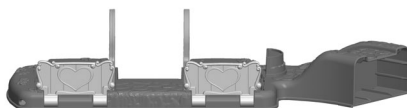

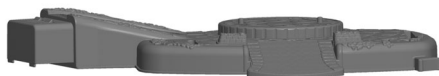
Stable Base

Back Ramp

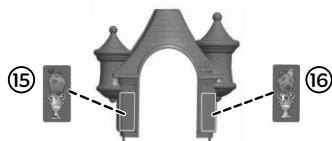


Tower Base



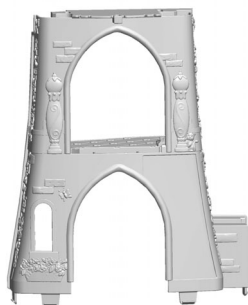
Lower Ramp

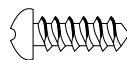


Tower Roof

IMPORTANT! Apply labels to the front of the tower roof **BEFORE** beginning assembly.



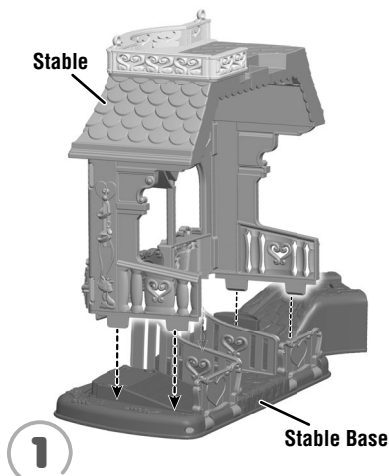

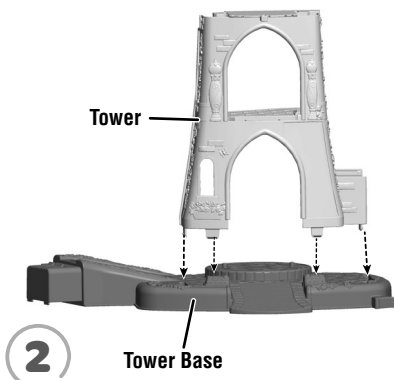
M3,5 mm x 12 mm Screw - 3

Screw shown actual size. Tighten and loosen screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.

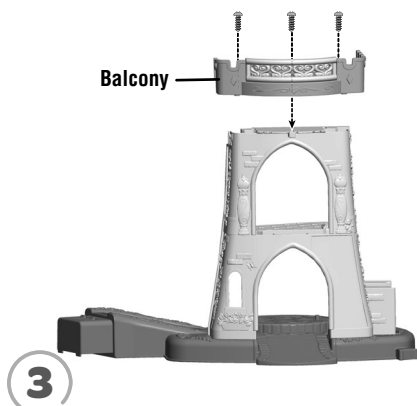
Assembly



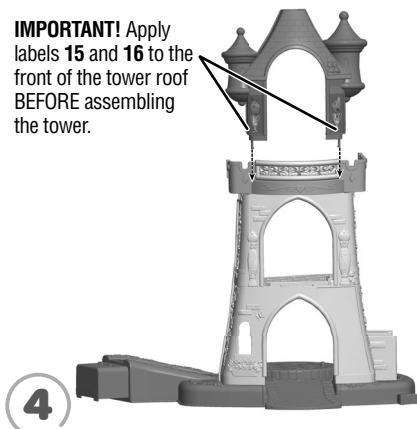
- Insert the tabs on the stable into the slots in the stable base. Push to **“snap”** in place.



- Insert the tabs on the tower into the slots in the tower base. Push to **“snap”** in place.

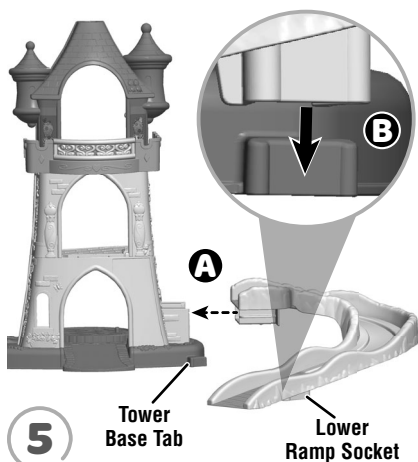


- Fit the balcony onto the tower. Insert three screws into the balcony and tighten.

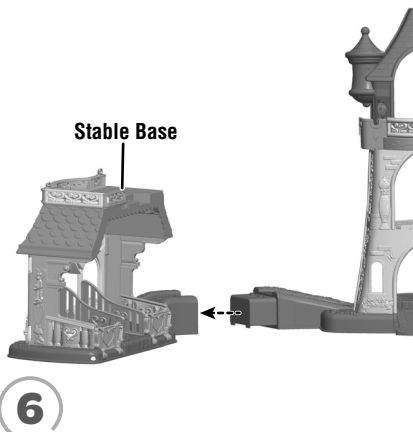


- Fit the tower roof onto the balcony. Push to **“snap”** in place.

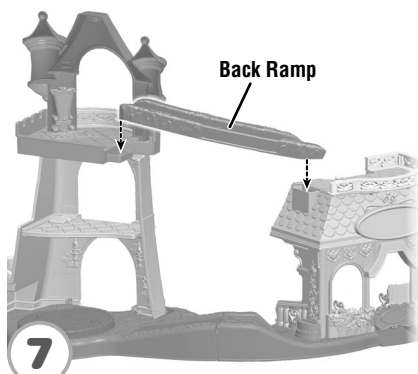
Assembly



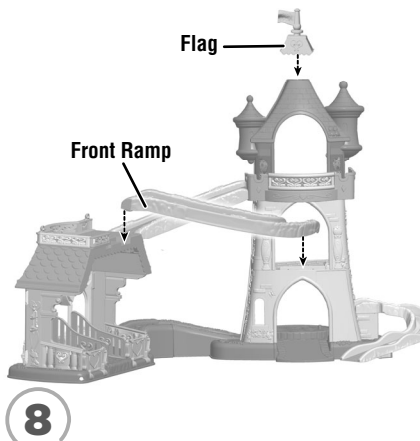
- First, slide and “snap” the upper end of the lower ramp into the side of the tower **A**. Then, push near the lower end of the ramp to fit the ramp socket to the tower base tab **B**.



- Fit the end of the tower base into the opening in the end of the stable base. Push to “snap” each base together.



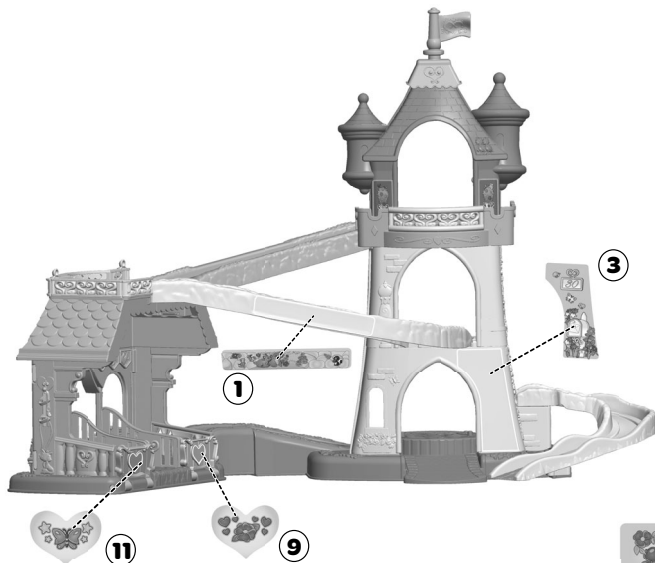
- Fit the tabs on the back ramp into the sockets in the tower and the stable. Push to “snap” each end of the ramp in place.



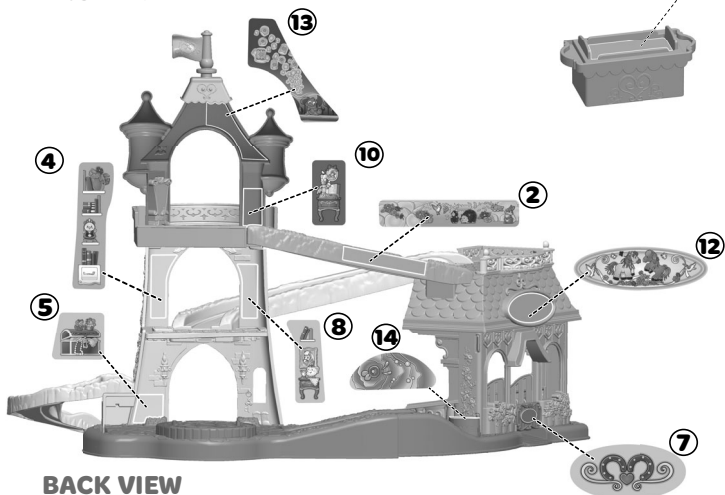
- Fit the tabs on the front ramp into the sockets on the stable and the tower. Push to “snap” each end of the ramp in place.
- Fit the flag onto the tower roof.

Decoration

Apply labels exactly as shown in illustrations. Avoid repositioning a label after it has been applied.



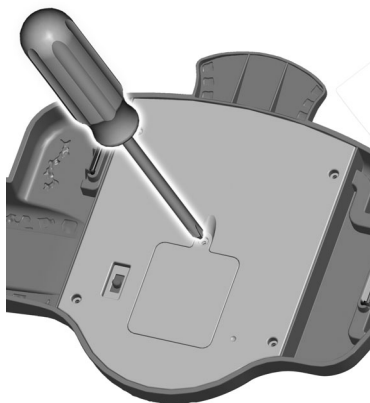
FRONT VIEW

Battery Installation

Use **alkaline** batteries for longer life.

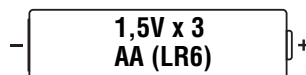


- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door and remove the door.
- Insert three AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw.
- If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power switch off and back on.
- When sounds become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.

Battery Safety Information



In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Lots of play on all sides!



Place a horse on the ramp. Tap the tail and watch it “klip-klop” down!

Hint: For best results, be sure the ramp and the horse's feet are clean and dry. Wipe with a damp cloth to clean and dry thoroughly.

Listen to music and sounds as the horse rides through the doorway.



Slide the power/volume switch on the bottom of the toy to ON with low volume , ON with high volume  or OFF .



Spin the thumbwheel for music and to make the horse “dance”.

Hint: This toy times out after several minutes of inactivity. Spin the thumbwheel to wake it up.
