Assembly



- Fit the two mountain halves together, as shown.
- Insert six screws into the mountain assembly and tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.





"Snap" the support pillars to the underside of the spiral track assembly, as shown, working from the shortest pillar to the longest. "Snap" the plain guardrail into the slots in the upper spiral track.






