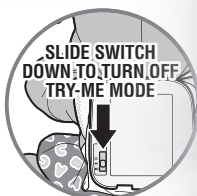




Open the fasteners on the back of the puppy. Slide the power/volume to ON with low volume  or ON with high volume  to turn off try-me demonstration mode.

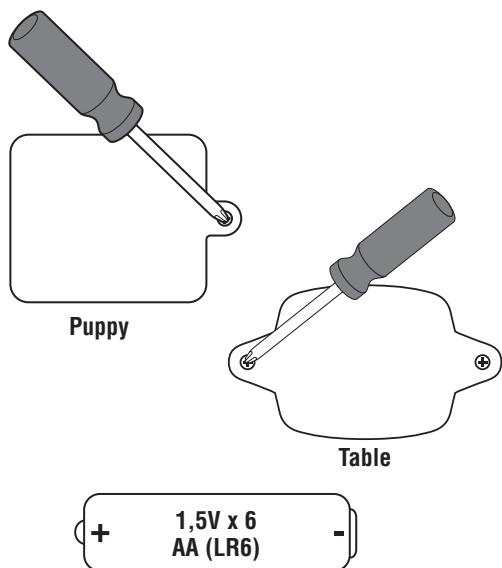
Care

Battery Replacement



Battery Safety Information

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the product before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

- For longer life, use **alkaline** batteries.
- For the puppy, open the fasteners on the back of the toy to access the battery compartment.
- Loosen the screw in each battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver and remove each door.
- Remove the exhausted batteries and dispose of them properly.
- Insert three, new AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries in the table and in the puppy.
- Replace the battery compartment doors and tighten each screw. Do not over-tighten the screws.
- If either toy begins to operate erratically you may need to reset the electronics. For the table, slide the power/mode switch off and then back on. For the puppy, slide the power/volume switch off and then back on.
- When sounds/lights from these toys become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.

Table Assembly for Stand & Cruise

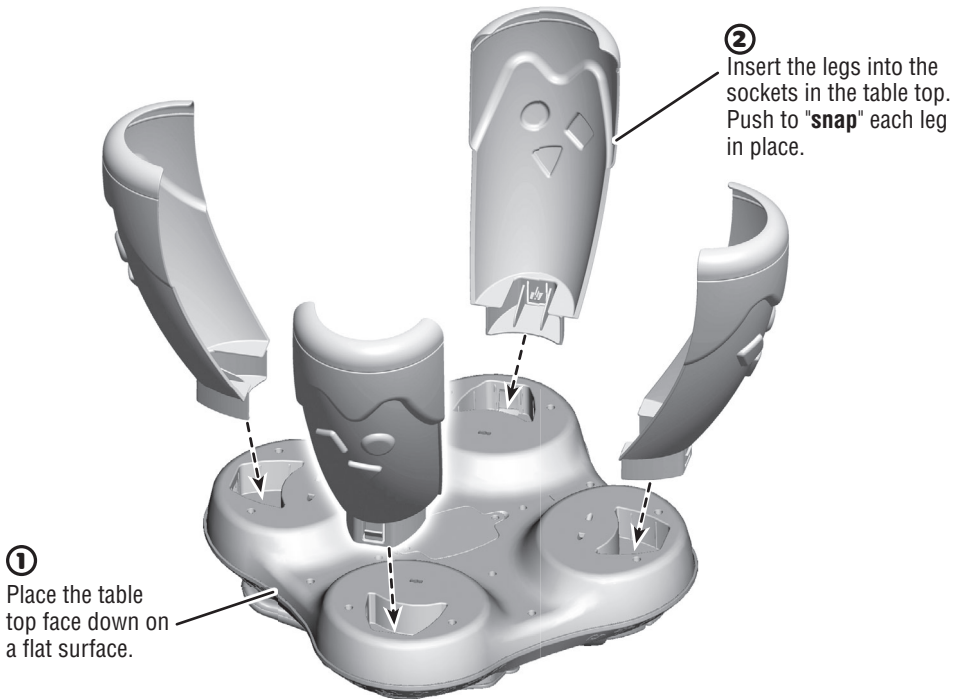


Table Disassembly for Sit & Play

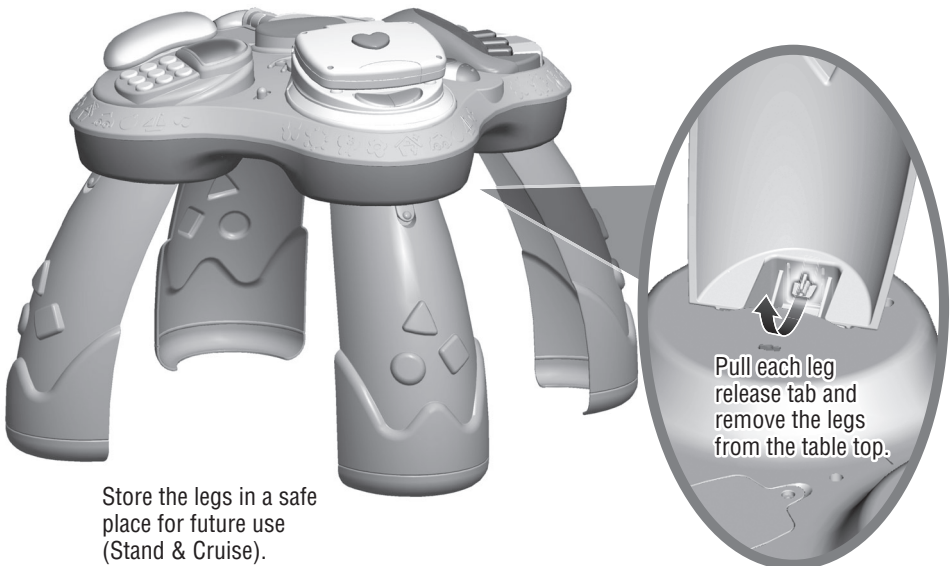


Table has four modes of play!

Imagination - Hear lots of fun sounds!

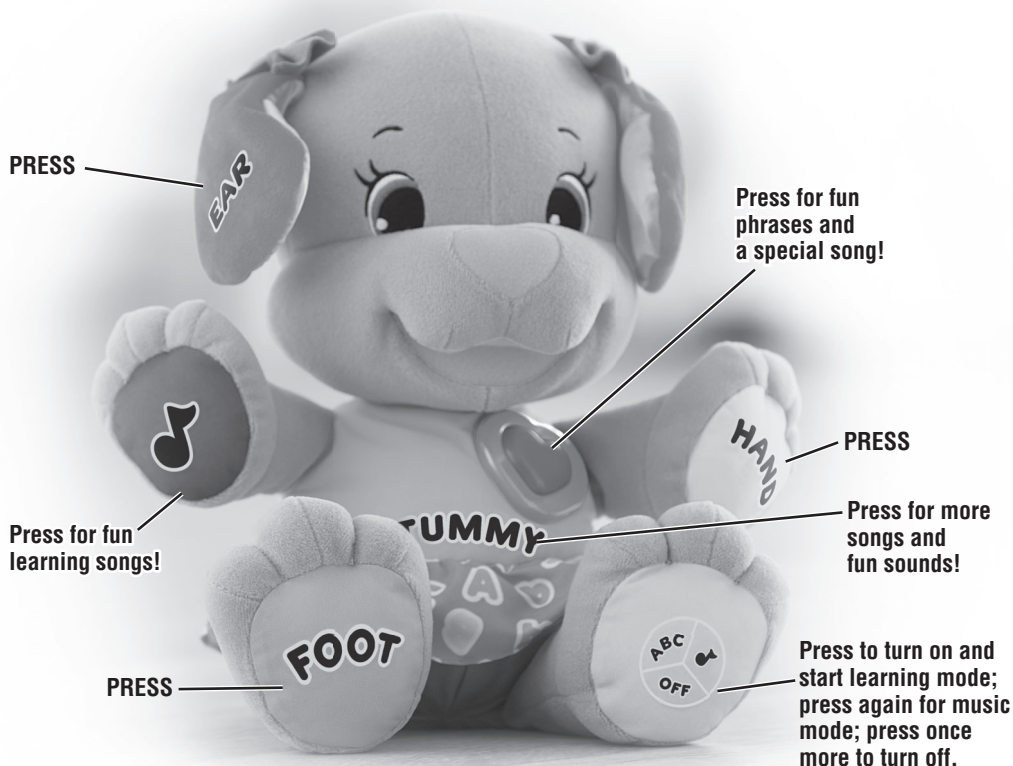
