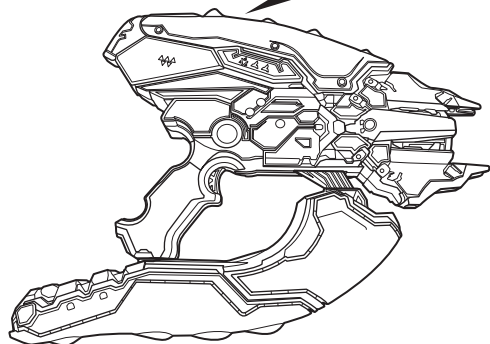
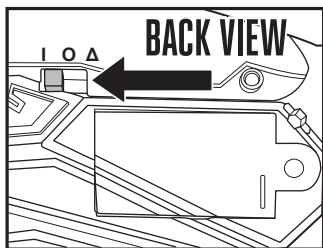
**WARNING:** Do not aim at eyes or face. Only use projectiles supplied with this toy. Do not fire at point blank range.  
**TO AVOID INJURY:** Do not modify rounds, darts, or dart blaster. Always wear appropriate eye-wear, sold separately.



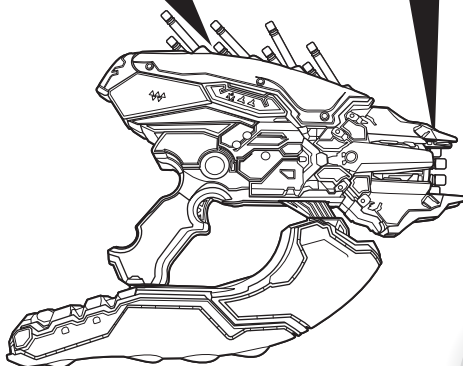
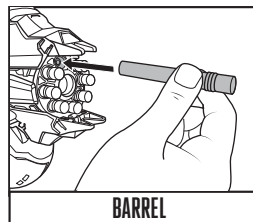
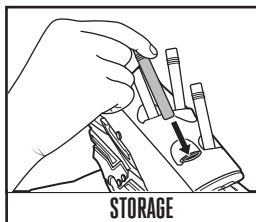
### 2 SET UP

A. Flip switch to I (ON).

Δ: TRY ME

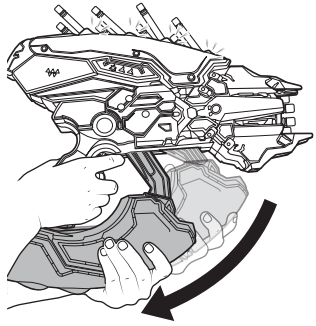


B. Load darts into barrel and storage.

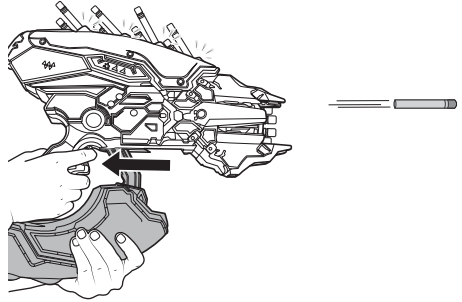


### 3 SINGLE-FIRE

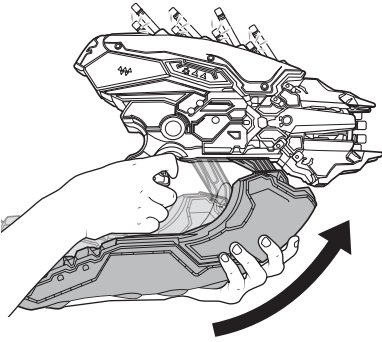
A. Pull handle back to charge blaster.



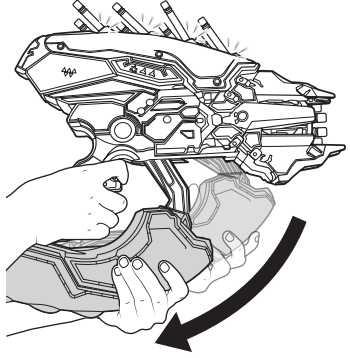
B. Pull trigger to fire!



C. Push handle back up.

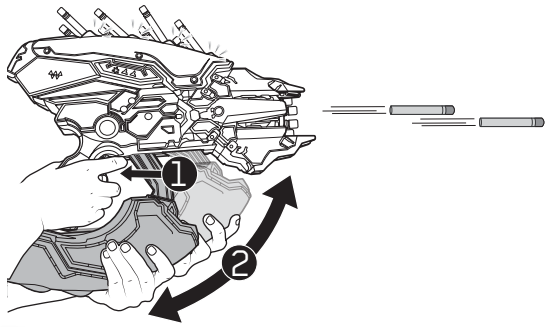


D. Pull handle back to charge blaster again.



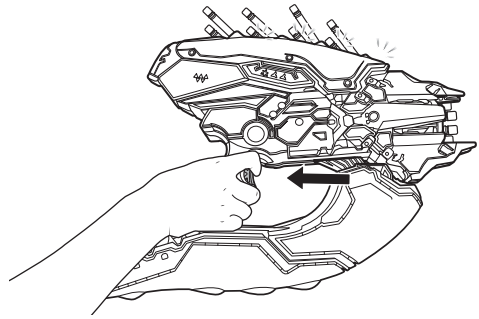
### 4 RAPID-FIRE

Pull and hold trigger, crank handle up and down for rapid-fire!



### 5 PERFORMANCE TIPS

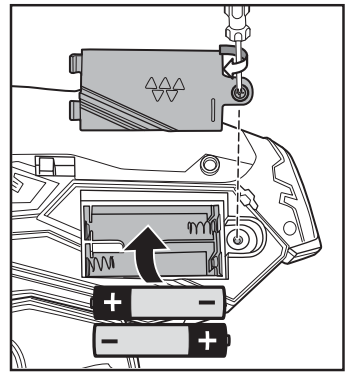
To reset the number of lit-up lights, press trigger when blaster is uncharged.



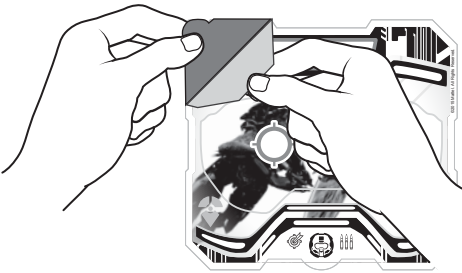
## 6 BATTERY REPLACEMENT

- Batteries included are for demonstration purposes only.
- Replace the batteries if lights dim.
- Unscrew the battery cover with a Phillips head screwdriver (not included).
- Install 2 new AA (LR6) alkaline batteries in the orientation (+/-) shown.
- Replace battery cover and tighten screw.
- For best performance, use alkaline batteries.
- When exposed to an electrostatic source, the blaster may malfunction.  
To resume normal operation, flip the power switch to OFF and ON again.

**NOTE:** This blaster is equipped with an automatic shut-off feature to help preserve battery life.

Peel backing off target before sticking it to surface.

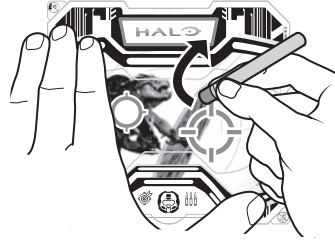
**✘ Do not stick target to walls or furniture as it may cause damage to the surface.**

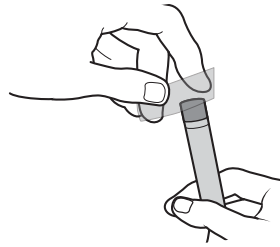


## 8 REMOVING DARTS

Keep one hand pressed on target, hold dart by the tip and gently peel dart off.



**REMOVE DARTS IMMEDIATELY TO MAINTAIN SMART STICK™ TECHNOLOGY!**



Dust, dirt, and other debris can cause darts to lose their adhesiveness. To clean darts, rinse darts' tips with tap water or use tape to remove excess debris.

**NOTE:** Dry darts before using again.

## BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION
