REQUIRED NOT INCLUDED










WARNING: Do not aim at eyes or face. Only use projectiles supplied with this toy. Do not fire at point blank range.


TO AVOID INJURY: Do not modify rounds, darts, or dart blaster. Always wear appropriate eye-wear, sold separately.



Attach chambers to blaster before play.











- Requires 6 AA (LR6) alkaline batteries (not included).
- Unscrew the battery cover with a Phillips head screwdriver (not included).
- Install 6 new AA (LR6) alkaline batteries in the orientation (+/-) shown.
- Replace battery cover and tighten screw.
- Replace batteries if motor slows down.
- For best performance, use alkaline batteries.




3 TO PLAY


A. Fully load the two bottom chambers with darts. **B.** Hold button and pump to access top chamber. Continue Loading.



NOTE: Darts should be pushed all the way back and locked under the tabs when loaded.




C. Hold button to rev motor. Pull trigger and release quickly for single fire!




IMPORTANT: Chambers must be properly aligned to blaster when revving motor.

 $\textbf{D.} \ \ \text{Rev motor.} \ \textbf{Fully press} \ \text{and} \ \textbf{fully release} \ \text{trigger repeatedly for rapid fire!}$




E. Hold button and pump the grip to advance to the next chamber.






Blaster may be jammed if it is loaded but will not fire:

To clear a jam, hold button and pump the grip to eject the jammed dart.



5 ATTACHING TARGETS




★ Do not stick target to walls or furniture as it may cause damage to the surface.

Peel backing off target before sticking it to surface.

REMOVING DARTS

Keep one hand pressed on target, hold dart by the tip and gently peel dart off.





Dust, dirt, and other debris can cause darts to lose their adhesiveness.

To clean darts, rinse darts' tips with tap water or use tape to remove excess debris.

NOTE: Dry darts before using again.
