Q: Why can't my car fully enter the pit lane to recharge? A: Your car might be traveling too fast when it enters the pit lane. Push your car forward into the pit lane to continue



- Q. My car keeps crashing on the track for no reason. What is the problem?
- A. Clear all obstructions on the track. Adjust track side walls at each connection point.
- Q. My Speed Chargers car keeps slowing down by itself on the tracks even though it is charged.
- A. Lint may collect around your car's axles. This may cause the car to run slowly. Use tweezers or a toothpick to remove lint.

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- Unscrew the battery cover with a Phillips head screwdriver (not included).
- Install 9 AA (LR6) alkaline batteries (not included) in the orientation (+/-) shown.
- Replace battery cover and tighten screw. \bullet Replace the batteries in the top or bottom row when pit
- lane on that side can no longer charge cars. • Replace the batteries in the middle row when lap counter
- lights dim. For longer life use alkaline batteries. • When exposed to an electrostatic source, the product may malfunction. To resume normal operation, remove and

re-install the batteries.
