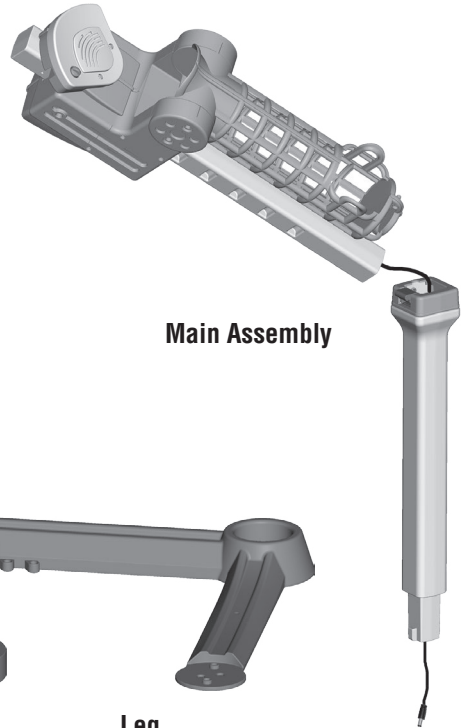

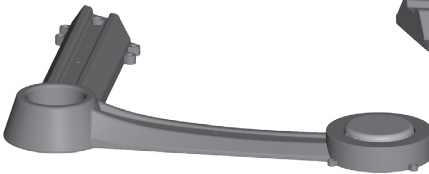
Lower Arm



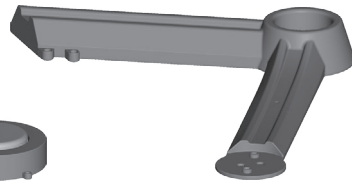
Upper Arm



Main Assembly



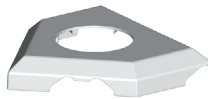
Leg with Button

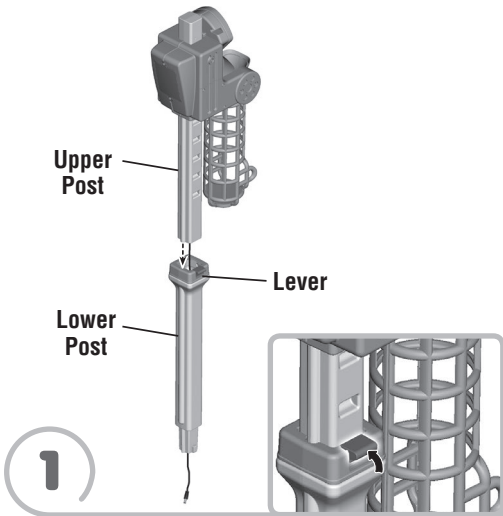


M3,5 x 1,6 cm Screw - 14

Note: Tighten and loosen all screws with a Phillips Screwdriver. Do not over-tighten the screws.

Assembly



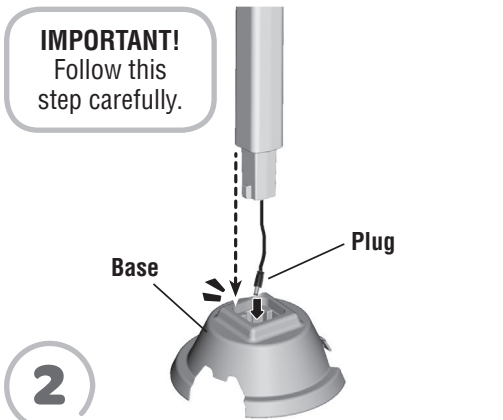
- Align the rib on the upper post to the groove in the lower post (on the main assembly). Slide the upper post into the lower post.

Hint: This will require some force.

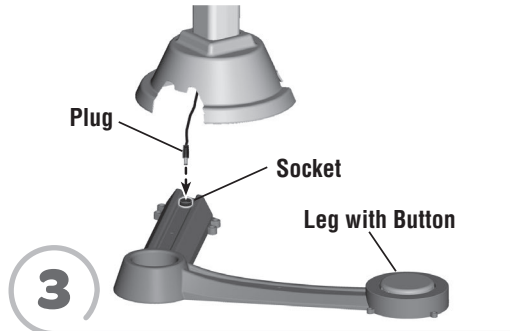
- Push the lever into one of the slots on the side of the upper post.

IMPORTANT!

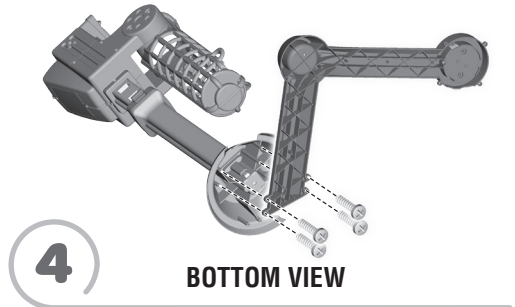
Follow this step carefully.



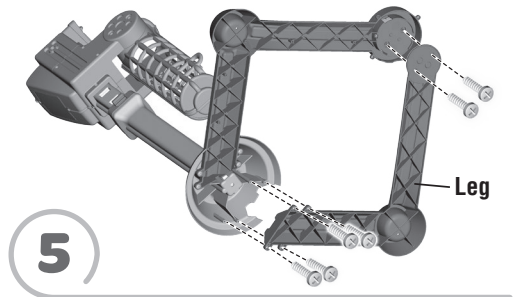
- Feed the plug on the end of the lower post down through the hole in the base.
- **"Snap"** the lower post into the base.



- Fit the plug coming from the underside of the base into the socket in the leg with the button.



- Turn the assembly on its side.
- Fit the base onto the leg with the button.
- Insert four screws into the bottom of the leg and tighten.



- Fit the other leg to the assembly.
- Insert six screws into the leg and tighten.

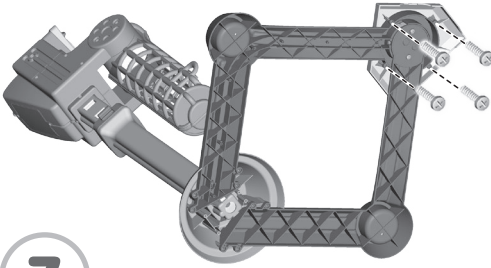

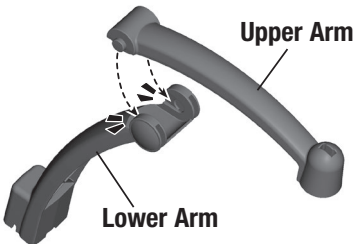
- Turn the assembly upright.
- Place home plate over the the button on the leg assembly for either a left or right-handed batter.

- Turn the assembly on its side.
- Insert four screws into the leg assembly and tighten.

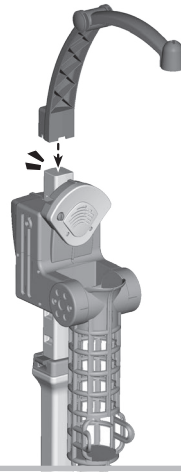

- **"Snap"** the upper arm to the lower arm.

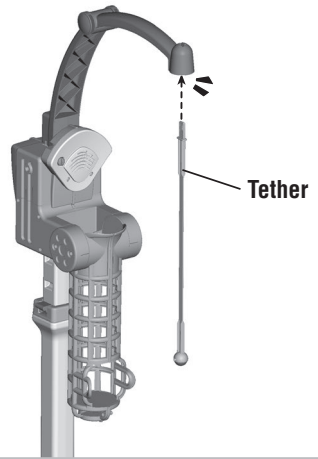

- **"Snap"** the arm assembly to the top of the main assembly.

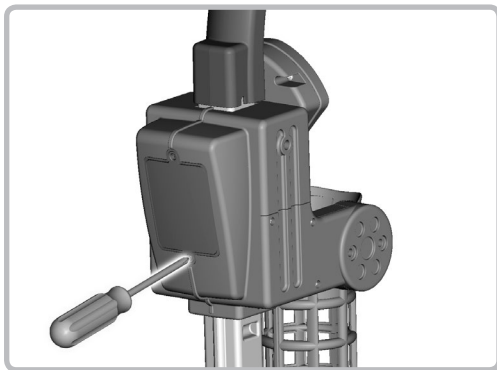

- **"Snap"** the tether up into the arm.



Battery Installation



- Locate the battery compartment on the toy.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door and remove the door.
- Insert three C (LR14) **alkaline** batteries.

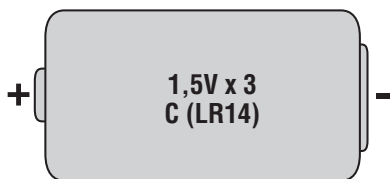
Hint: We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws.
- If this product begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Turn the power switch off and then back again to turn on.
- When sounds or motion become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!



- Protect the environment by not disposing of this product with household waste (2012/19/EU). Check your local authority for recycling advice and facilities.

Battery Safety Information



In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.

Step-up to the Plate!

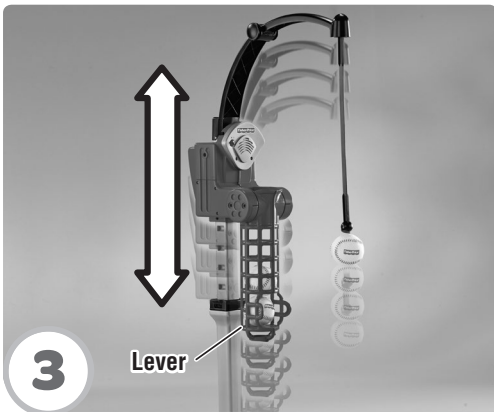
IMPORTANT! Only use balls supplied with this toy.



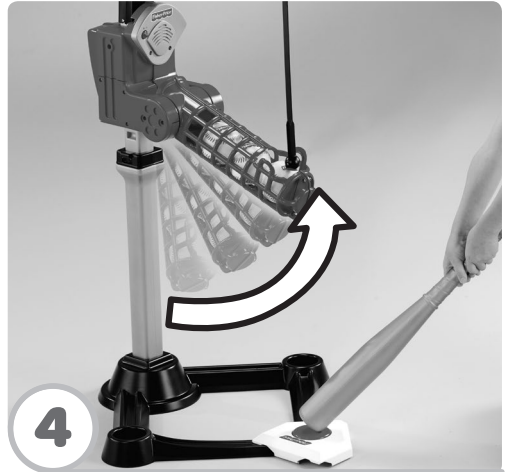
- Load the balls into the cage.



- Turn the power switch to ON.



- Lift the lever and raise or lower the post to the appropriate height for your child.
- Push the lever into one of the slots on the side of the upper post to secure the height.



- Tap home plate with the end of your bat to load a ball.

Hint: For best results, make sure the balls are clean and dry.



- Swing and hit the ball.
- Tap home plate again to load another ball.
- When you're finished playing with the toy, turn the power switch to OFF.

Consumer Information

Tips

- We recommend that this toy be used outdoors.
- Do not use outdoors when it is raining or there is wet grass. The balls will not load properly.
- Be sure that when your child is batting, there are no other children in or around the batting area, including directly in front of the toy.
- This toy is designed for use with soft balls and plastic bat (both included). It is not designed for use with wooden or metal bats, or regulation baseballs or softballs. Use of these balls and bats may damage this toy.
- Hold the bat with hands together, about one or two inches (2,5 - 5 cm) from the knob at the end of the bat.
 - Right-handed batters should have the right hand on top of the left hand.
 - Left-handed batters should have the left hand on top of the right hand.
- Stand with feet about shoulder width apart.
- Swing with a smooth and level motion.

Care

- Do not leave this product outdoors. Store this product indoors when not in use.
- This product may be wiped clean using a mild cleaning solution and a damp cloth. Do not use bleach. Do not use harsh or abrasive cleaners. Rinse clean with water to remove residue. Do not immerse this product.
- Periodically inspect this product for wear and damage and replace any cracked parts.
