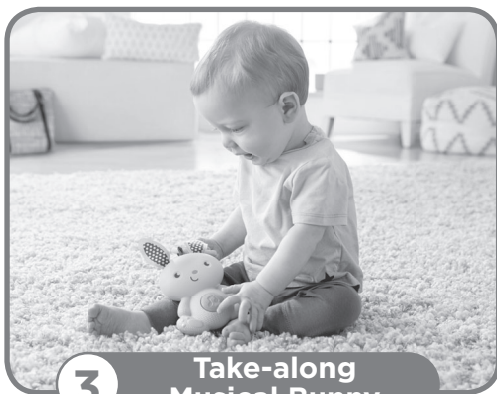

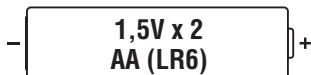

Battery Installation



For longer life, use **alkaline** batteries.



- Locate the battery compartment door on the back of the musical bunny.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver and remove the door.
- Insert two, new AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws. Do not over-tighten.
- If the musical bunny begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power/volume switch off and back on.
- When sound from the musical bunny becomes faint or stops, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.



Protect the environment by not disposing of this product or any batteries with household waste. This symbol indicates that this product shall not be treated as household waste. Check your local authority for recycling advice and facilities.

Battery Safety Information

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid **battery leakage**:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable.
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.

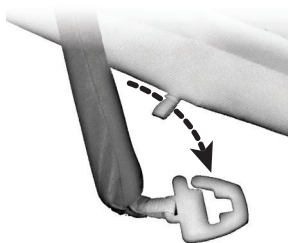
Wrap-around Vine



Mat with Arches

Care

The mat is machine washable.
Remove the arch assembly from the mat.



- While holding a mat loop, carefully unhook an arch clip. Repeat this process to unhook the remaining arch clips from the mat.
- Machine wash the mat, tummy wedge, wrap-around vine and carrot toy in cold water on the gentle cycle. Do not use bleach. Tumble dry on low heat.
- The arch assembly, musical bunny, mirror and toys are surface washable only. Wipe with a clean cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution. Do not immerse.

Setup



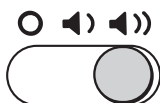
- Hang the toys from loops on the arches. Or attach the toys to the loops on the wrap-around vine and the tummy wedge.
- Wind the wrap-around vine around the arches at the top of the gym.
- Wrap the straps on the mirror toy around an arch or a loop and close the fasteners.



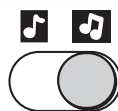
WARNING

Power/Volume Switch



Mode Switch

- Slide the power/volume switch on the musical bunny to ON with low volume, ON with high volume or OFF.
- Slide the mode switch on the musical bunny to short play mode or long play mode.
- In **short play mode** , hear a short tune each time you press the button on the musical bunny.
- In **long play mode** , press the button on the musical bunny to start 10 minutes of continuous music. When the music stops, press the button again for another 10 minutes of music.
