



C. Press and hold the button for music.




A. Tap the button for sounds. B. Press the button for phrases.



Note: The helmet is equipped with an automatic shut-off feature that helps preserve battery life.





A. Attach headset to enhance tactical play.




Camera and mount not included. Not for use with some cameras and mounts.

5 BATTERY REPLACEMENT

- Batteries included are for demonstration purposes only.
- · Replace the batteries if sounds distort.
- · Unscrew the battery cover with a Phillips head screwdriver (not included).
- Remove batteries and dispose of them safely.
- Install 3 new button cell (AG13, LR44) batteries in the orientation (+/-) shown.
- · Replace battery cover and tighten screw.
- For best performance, use only alkaline batteries.
- When exposed to an electrostatic source, the product may malfunction. To resume normal operation, remove and re-install the batteries.



BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION

In exceptional circumstances batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- · Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the product before being charged.
- · Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable batteries.
- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
