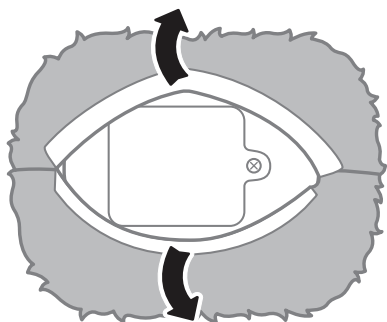

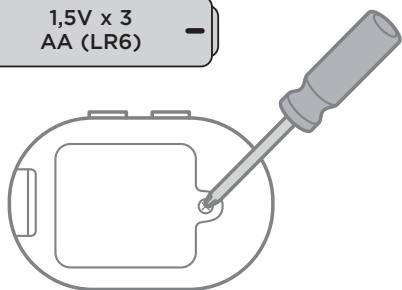
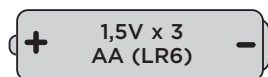

## REPLACE BATTERIES

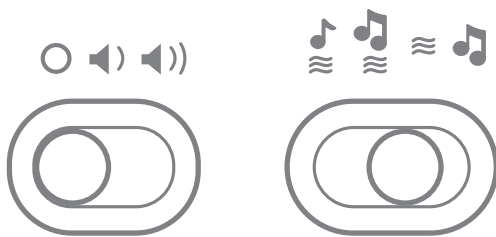


- Open the fasteners and remove the electronic unit.



- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips and remove the door.
- Remove the exhausted batteries and properly dispose.
- Insert three, new AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw. Do not over-tighten.
- When vibrations or sound from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.
- If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power-volume switch off and back on.

## POWER-VOLUME & MODE SWITCHES



- Before replacing the electronic unit, turn power on, select a volume level and mode for use.
  - ◀ On with Low Volume
  - ◀) On with High Volume
  - Off
- - ♪ Short Play

  - ≡ Vibration Only
  - ♪ Music Only
- With the speaker facing the front of the toy, fit the electronic unit inside the toy. Close the fasteners.

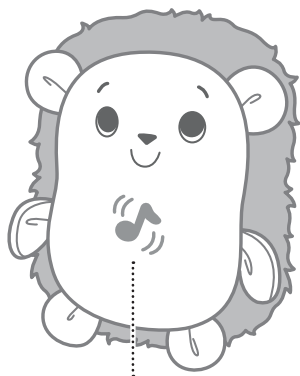
## CARE
