




B. Squeeze legs for sounds and to pop out wings!



3 PERFORMANCE TIPS

If wings do not fully pop out or the right arm is not raised up completely, follow the steps to reset:

- (a) Squeeze and hold legs.
- (b) Rotate the right arm downward.
- (c) Rotate the right arm upward.
- (d) Release legs.



4 BATTERY REPLACEMENT

- Batteries included are for demonstration purposes only.
- Replace the batteries if lights dim or sounds distort.
- Unscrew the battery cover with a Phillips head screwdriver (not included).
- · Remove batteries and dispose of them safely.
- Install 3 new AG13 (LR44) button cell batteries in the battery box.
- · Replace battery cover and tighten screw.
- · For best performance, use only alkaline batteries.
- When exposed to an electrostatic source, the product may malfunction. To resume normal operation, remove and reinstall the batteries.

NOTE: This product is equipped with an automatic shut-off feature that helps preserve battery life.
