# P1

out the dinosaur's closest relative.



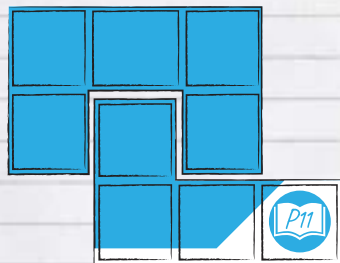
# Doc Gnaw Last
