

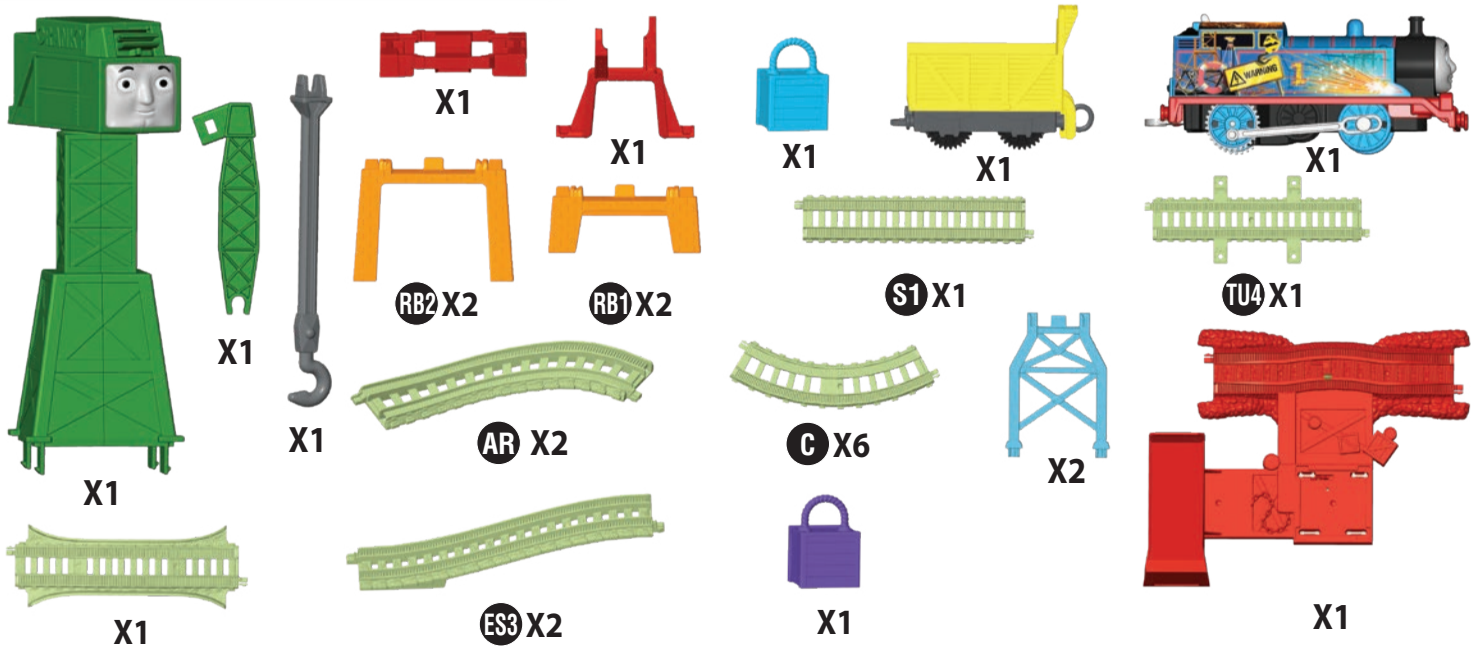

HYPER GLOW NIGHT DELIVERY INSTRUCTIONS

Track marking codes are found on the bottom of tracks and riser.

Note: Some engines may not work on this track set.

Adult assembly required. No tools needed.

★ ONE-TIME SNAP: Assembly step that is marked with a star is a "one-time snap." Once this part is put together, it cannot be taken apart.

Metal engines will not activate motorized features of TrackMaster™ playsets.

The engine's body also glows in the dark. Expose the engine to light, then watch it glow in the dark. Place product approximately 5 feet (152 cm) away from a light source for 30 seconds. Placing product closer will not intensify the "glow-in-the-dark" feature. Glow-in-the-dark feature will last longer if you do not expose this product to intense heat or direct sunlight for prolonged periods of time.

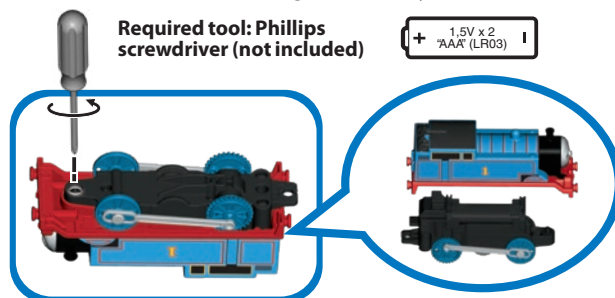
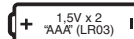
BATTERY INSTALLATION

Access the battery compartment by unscrewing and separating the top half of the engine from the bottom half of the engine. Install the batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment. Re-assemble the two halves of the engine, re-insert the screw and tighten. If the product begins to malfunction, check the battery installation. You may need to reset the electronics by removing the batteries and reinstalling them. If the product continues to malfunction or no longer operates, remove the batteries from the toy and replace them with fresh batteries. Requires 2 "AAA" (LR03) batteries, not included. For longer life use only alkaline batteries.

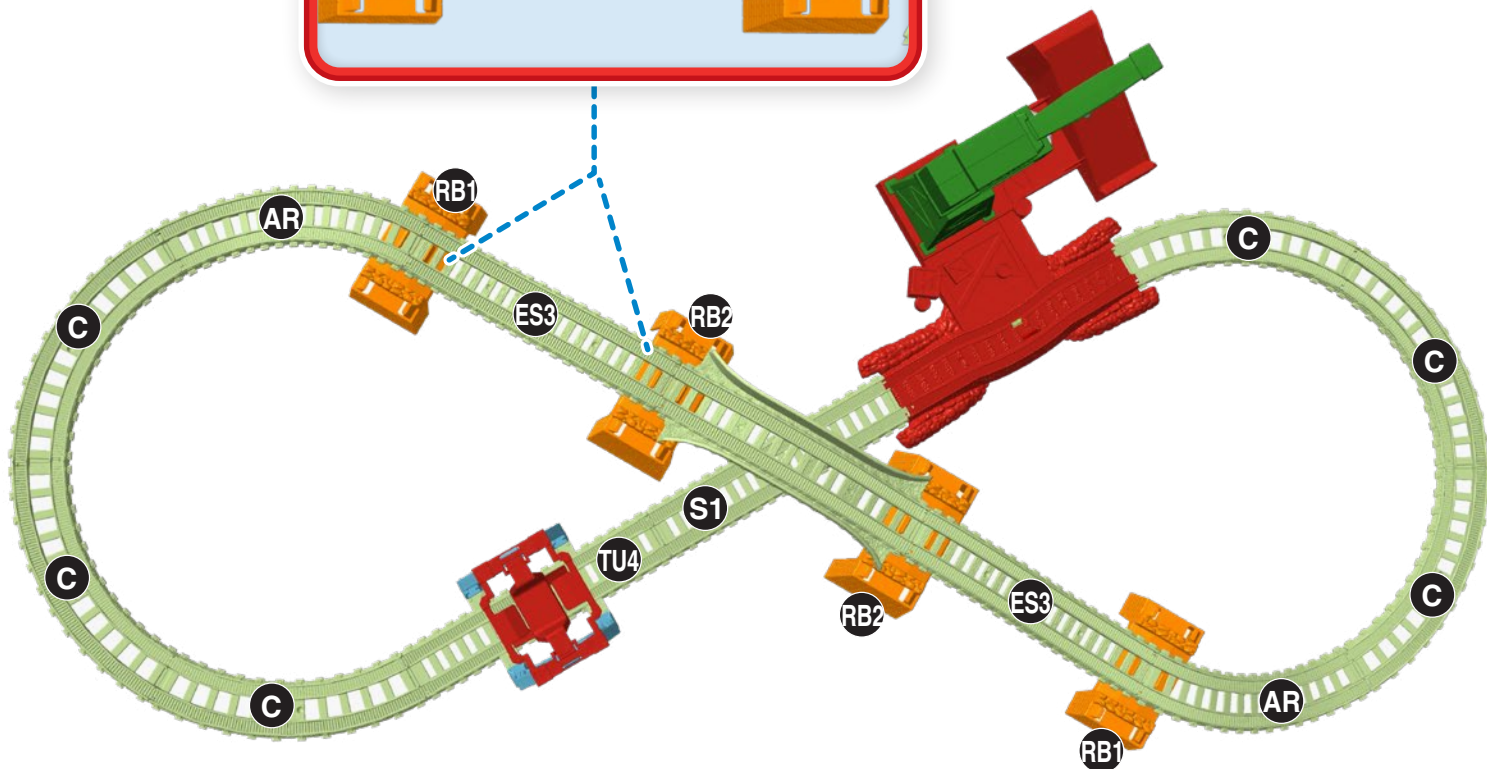
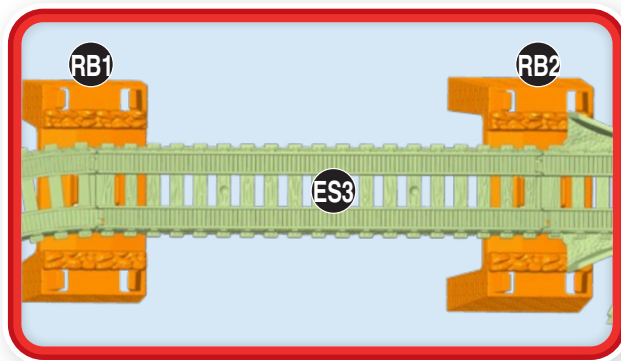
BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION

- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.

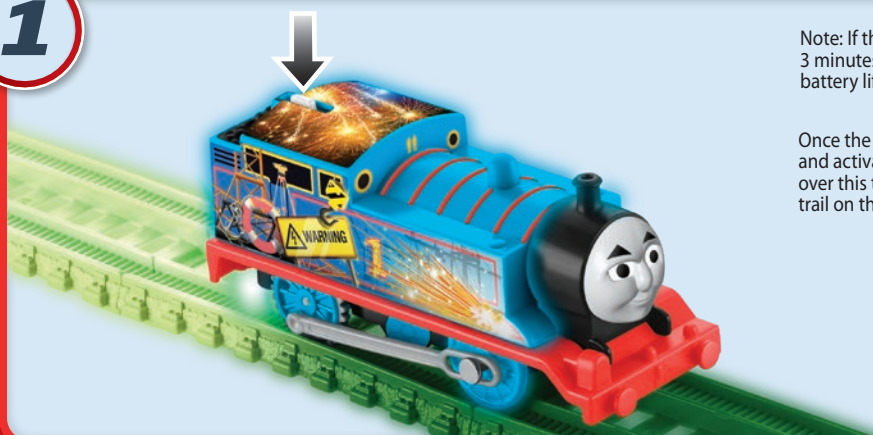


Track Layout

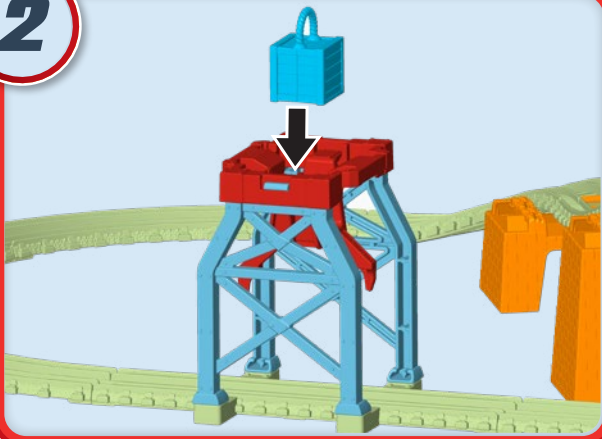
Note: If the engine runs continuously for approximately 3 minutes, it will automatically shut off to preserve battery life. To resume play, press the button on the engine.

Once the tail lights are on, the engine is ready to charge and activate glow-in-the-dark track. As the engine passes over this track with its tail lights on, it will leave a glowing trail on the tracks behind it.

Press the button once to start the engine and watch its tail lights light up. Press the button again to stop the engine and turn off the tail light effect.

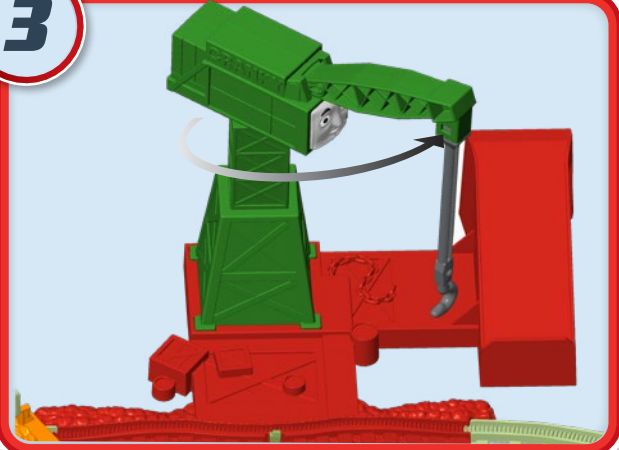

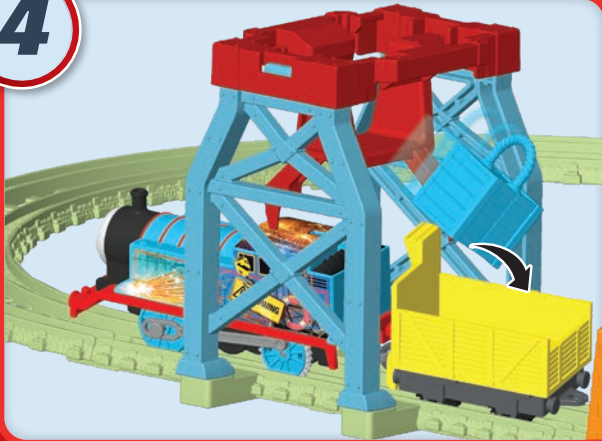
Load the cargo into the cradle .
Note: Ensure the crate is upright, with the handle on top, exactly as shown in the image.

Wind Cranky in the direction shown until he locks into place.

As the cargo car passes, it tips the cradle and triggers the cargo crate to fall down into it.

As the engine passes the loading area, Cranky will spin and hook the cargo crate, then deliver the cargo down the chute.
