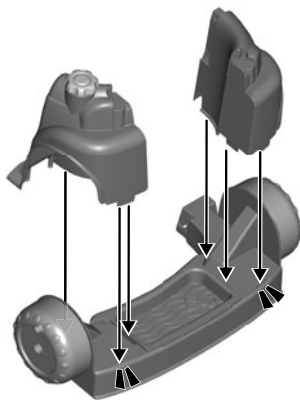
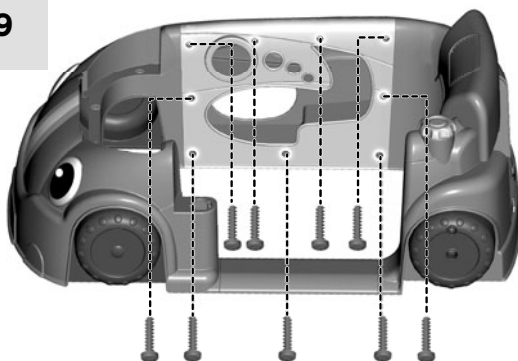
Tighten all screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.

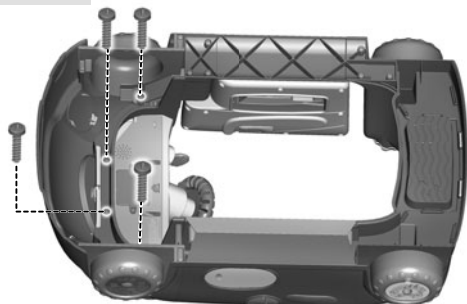


Fit the side panels to the front and back ends.

Turn the assembly upright to **"snap"** the door into place.

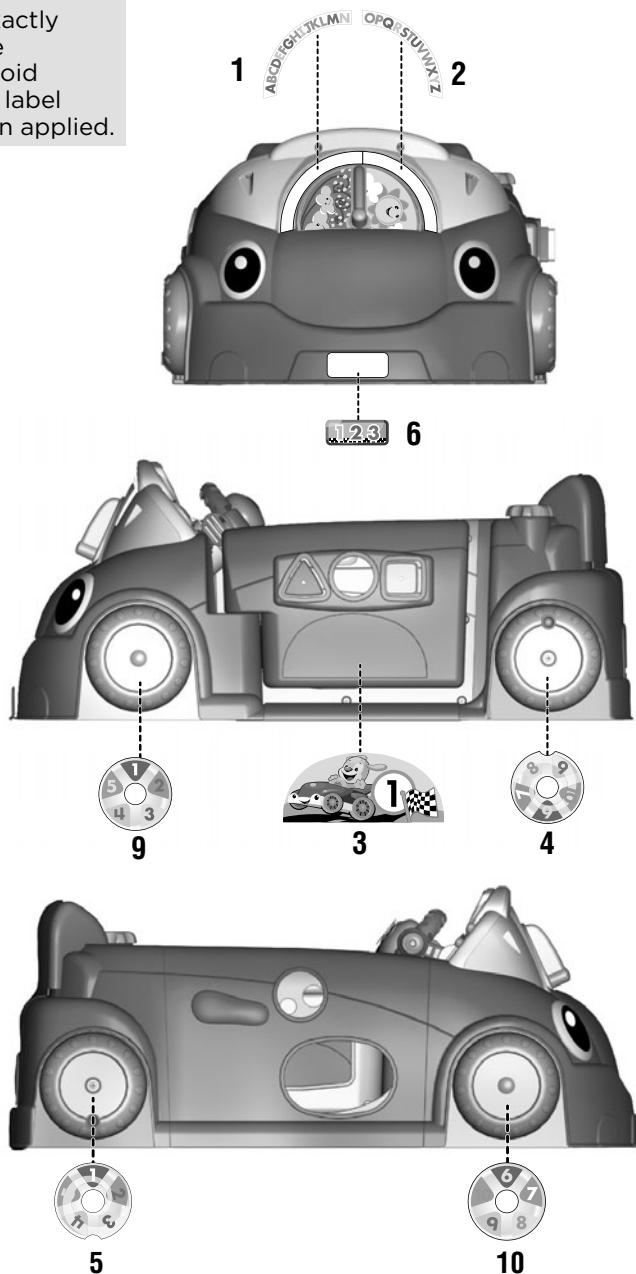


While holding the steering wheel in place, carefully turn the assembly over to assemble the screws.

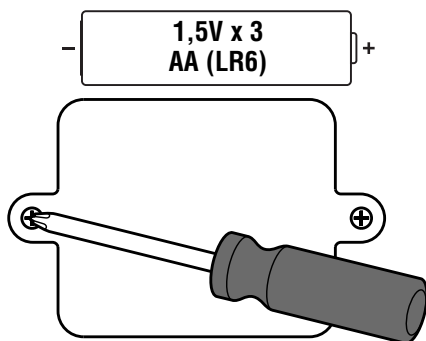

DECORATION

INSTALL BATTERIES



For longer life, use **alkaline** batteries.

Locate the battery compartment on the dashboard. Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door and remove the door.

Insert three AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.

Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw.

If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power-volume switch off and back on.

When sounds/lights become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.

Never short-circuit the battery terminals.

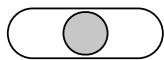
Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
