Requires three "AAA" (LR03) alkaline batteries (not included).


Adult assembly is required for battery installation.

Tool required for battery installation: Phillips screwdriver (not included).



Battery Installation





- Locate the battery compartment on the back of the toy.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three "AAA" (LR03) alkaline batteries, as indicated inside the battery compartment

Hint: We recommend using alkaline batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- When sounds become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!

Battery Safety Information

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of the product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the product before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Take Your Favorite Music Along!

• Insert the ROM cartridge into the slot in the player.



• Insert the headphone plug into the headphone jack.



- Place the headphones on your child's head.
- Turn the power/volume dial to adjust volume to a comfortable listening level.





- Press the play/pause button to start music. Press again to pause.
- Press the track forward button to move ahead to the next song on the ROM cartridge.

Hints:

- This toy plays for several minutes and then turns off automatically. To restart, press the play/pause button again.
- When you are finished listening, turn the power/volume dial until it "clicks" off.
