BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Includes 4 C batteries (R14) 1.5V. Batteries included are for demonstration purposes only. Battery replacement is required. Only adults should replace batteries. For longer battery life, use **alkaline** batteries. Required tool: Phillips screwdriver (not included).



Wipe this toy with a clean, damp cloth.
Do not immerse.



Protect the environment by not disposing of this product or any batteries with household waste. This symbol indicates that this product shall not be treated as household waste. Check your local authority for recycling advice and facilities.



Slide the power-volume switch to ON with silence , ON with low volume , ON with high volume  or OFF .

This toy goes into sleep mode after a period of inactivity. Activate any button, switch, dial, or knob to wake it up.

If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power-volume switch off and then back on again.

BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

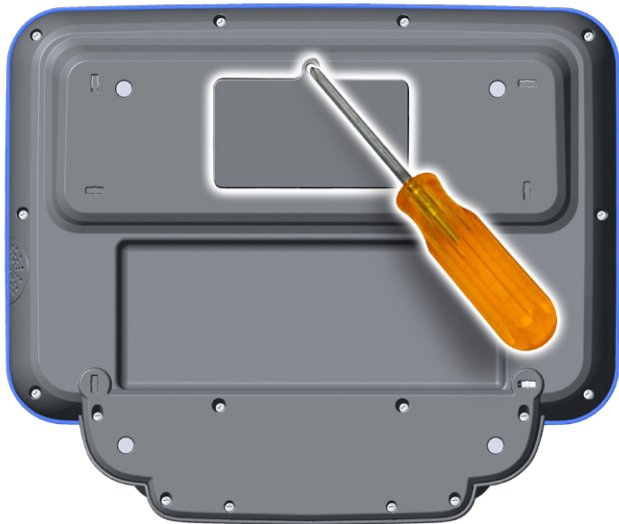
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

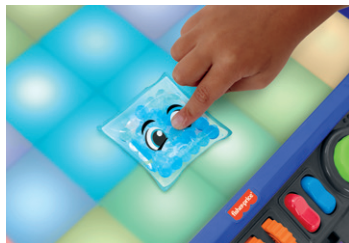


- Locate the battery compartment door on the bottom of the toy.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver and remove the door.
- Remove the exhausted batteries and properly dispose.
- Insert four, new C (LR14) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw. Do not overtighten.

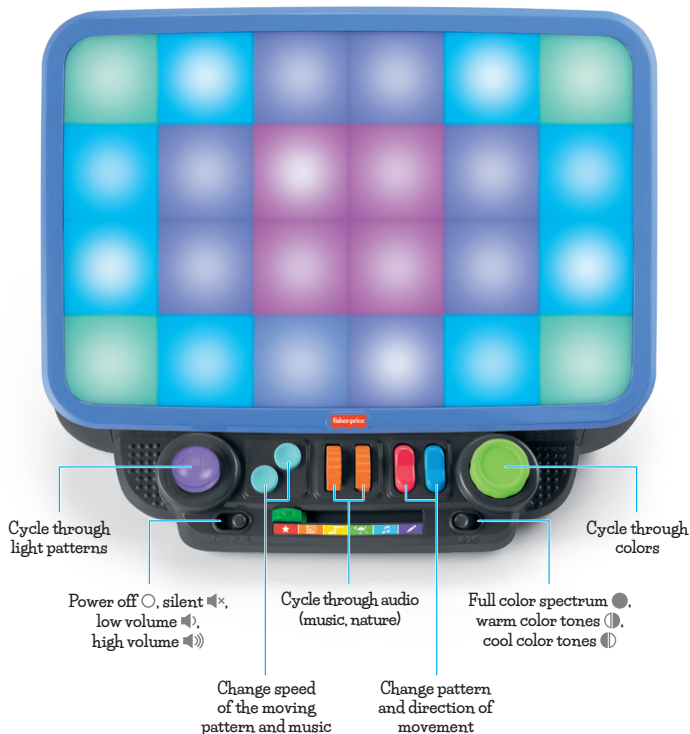

This mode is all about experimentation: turn a dial, press some buttons, flip a switch, and see what each combination does to the audio and light display.

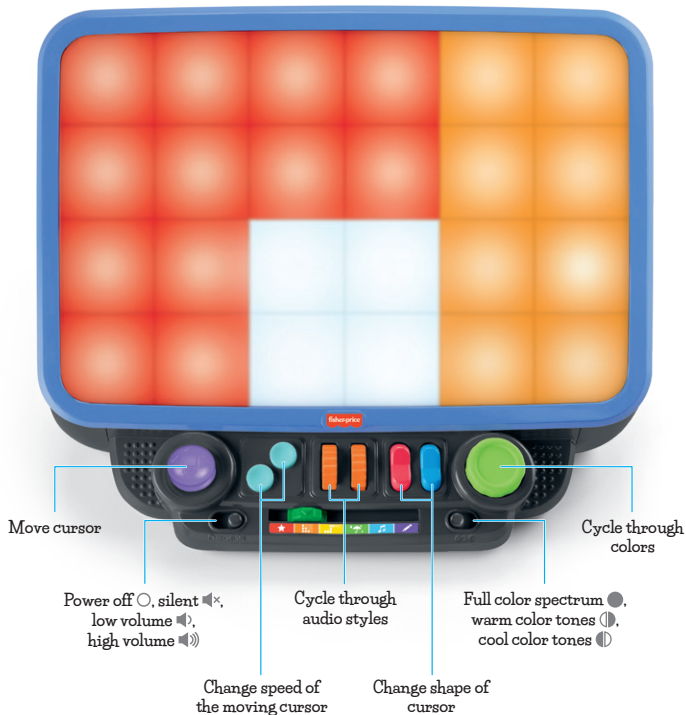




GLIDE

Wipe one color off to reveal a new one!

Direct the joystick to move a "wiper" cursor around the grid until every square has been touched and transformed into the next color, which restarts the play sequence. Progress is rewarded with audio and visual effects!









SNAKE

Find the food and make the snake grow!

Direct the joystick to turn the snake left or right as it moves forward automatically. When it "eats" the food, the snake grows and changes color. If the snake gets stuck, the game will start over. Progress is rewarded with audio and visual effects!

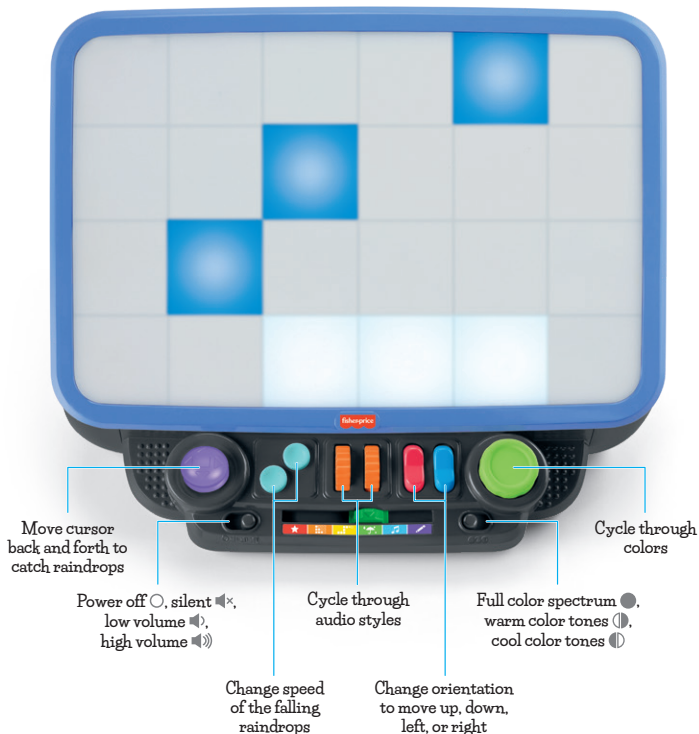

Catch the colored raindrops with the umbrella!

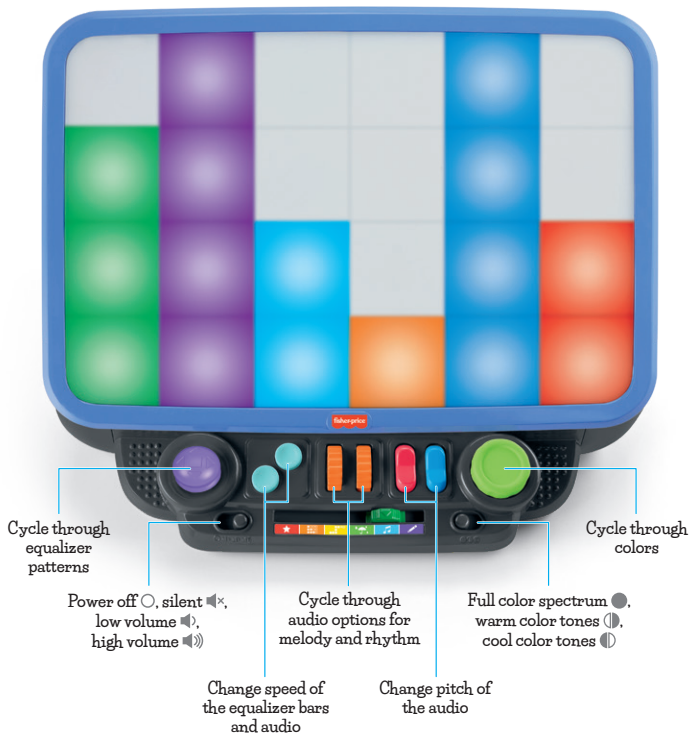
Direct the joystick to move the umbrella cursor in two directions along one edge of the grid and try to catch the raindrops. Special raindrops create fun bonus effects: grow the umbrella; shrink the umbrella; produce excessive "crazy rain". Progress is rewarded with audio and visual effects!



DJ DANCE PARTY™

Change the music and watch the light pattern follow along!

Use the controls to change the music's speed and the instrumentation of its melody and rhythm, independently.





ART

Pick any pic you have & start tracing—or just add a light-up color background!

In Art mode, this toy can be used like a traditional light table, but it also provides the ability to recolor segments of the grid. Crayon and paper not included.
