For longer life, use **alkaline** batteries.

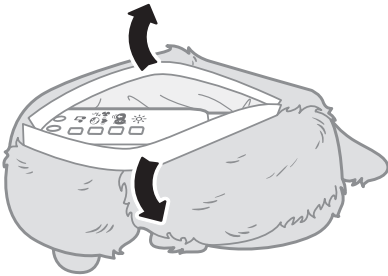
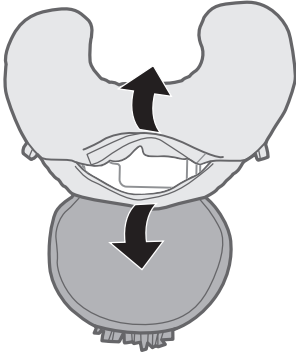
Battery replacement is required. Only adults

should replace batteries. Required tool:

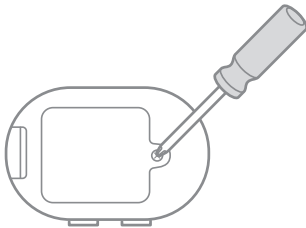
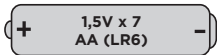

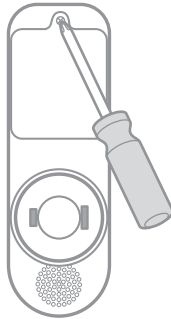
Replace Batteries



- Open the fasteners and pull to remove the electronic units.



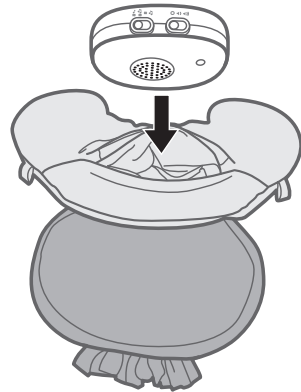
Tummy Wedge



Otter

- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment doors with a Phillips screwdriver and remove the doors.
- Remove the exhausted batteries and properly dispose.
- Insert three, new (LR6) **alkaline** batteries into the tummy wedge compartment. Insert four, new AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries into the otter compartment.
- Replace the battery compartment doors and tighten the screws. Do not over-tighten.

- When vibrations or sound from the tummy wedge become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.
- When music, sound, or motion from the otter become faint, slow or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.
- If the tummy wedge begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power-volume switch off and back on.
- If the otter begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Remove and reinstall the batteries.

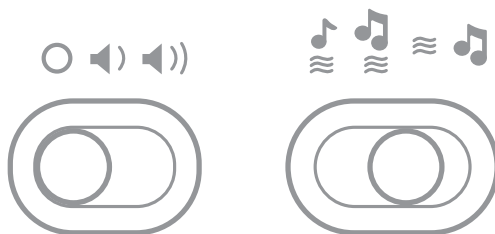


- Fit the electronic unit back inside the toy. Make sure the speaker/button faces the front of the toy and the power-volume and mode switches face you.
- Close the fasteners.



- With the speaker facing the front of the toy, fit the electronic unit to the tabs inside the toy. Before closing the fasteners, make music/sounds/motion selections and adjust volume.

Power-Volume & Mode Switches



- Turn the power on, select a volume level and mode for use.

Press here to start music, sound effects or vibrations. Press and hold for a few seconds to turn off. Note that music/sounds/vibration times stated below are approximate.

15 seconds of music and vibrations or a quick sound effect and vibrations
- ♪♪ **Long Play**
10 minutes of soothing music along with 5 minutes of calming vibrations
- ≡ **Vibration Only**
5 minutes of calming vibrations
- ♪ **Music Only**
10 minutes of soothing music

Soothing Sensations

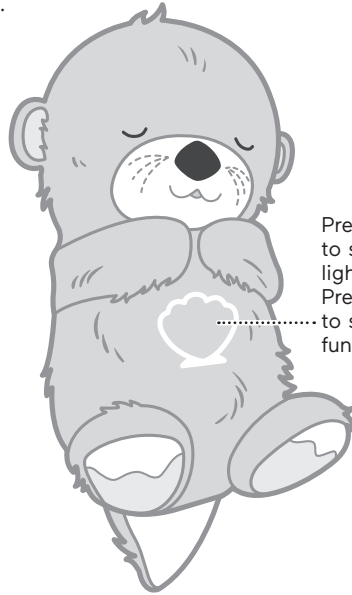
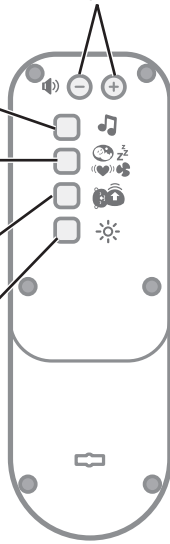
Press the **-** button to decrease volume and the **+** button to increase volume. Press both buttons to stop all functions.

Press this button to hear 30 minutes of soothing music.

Press this button to choose 30 minutes of soothing sounds including: nature, snoring, heartbeat, and white noise.

Press this button for 10 minutes of breathing motion.

Press this button for 15 minutes of soothing light.



Press my belly to start music/ lights/motion! Press and hold to stop all functions.

Note: Function times listed are approximate. Music and sounds will not play at the same time. If music is playing when the  button is pressed the music will fade and stop before starting the sounds. If sounds are playing when the  button is pressed the sounds will fade and stop before starting the music.

Care

- The tummy wedge and the otter are machine washable without the electronics unit. Do not immerse the electronics unit.
- Open the fasteners on the back of the toys and remove the electronics units.
- Place the koala teether in a pillowcase before washing. Machine wash the koala teether, the tummy wedge and the otter in cold water on the gentle cycle. Do not use bleach. Tumble dry on low heat.

Battery Safety Information
