Requires three "AA" batteries (included).

Adult assembly is required.

Tool required for assembly: Phillips screwdriver (not included).



Floor Gym








Parts

One-Time Assembly



This toy contains small parts in its unassembled state. Adult assembly is required.



- Position the arch so the underside is facing you. Note the post at one end of the arch.
- Fit a bracket onto the end of the arch with the post, making sure the post fits into the opening in the bracket.
- Fit the other bracket to opposite end of the arch.
- Insert two screws into each bracket and tighten.


Battery Safety Information



Please keep small parts such as the plastic tabs out of children's reach. Throw the plastic tab away.

Note: A plastic tab is attached to the toy for in-store demonstration purposes. Pull and remove the plastic tab from the back of the xylophone. Throw the plastic tab away.

Battery Replacement




For best performance, we recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with three, new alkaline "AA" (LR6) batteries.

- Locate the battery compartment on the back of the xylophone.
- Lift the hanger off the battery compartment door.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door and remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three "AA" (LR6) alkaline batteries, as indicated inside the battery compartment.

Hint: We recommend using *alkaline* batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws.
- "Snap" the hanger back in place.
- When lights or sounds from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!



In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the product before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Building the Floor Gym

To prevent entanglement injury, never place the gym in a crib or playpen. Never add strings, ties or other products to the gym.







- Insert and "snap" a leg into each end of the arch.
- Pull up on the arch to be sure it is secure.



While pressing the button on the neck of the xylophone insert and "snap" it into the opening in the arch.






Convert to a Rocker

Take Along Xylophone



- Press the button on the neck of the xylophone and pull to remove it from the top or bottom of the arch.
- "Snap" both hangers back onto the back of the xylophone.

3 Ways to Play!



Volume Switch

Slide the volume switch on back of the xylophone to high ◄
or low ◄
, for your child's comfort.



Mode Switch

- Slide the mode switch to **I**. Baby can press the xylophone keys or bat at the hanging toys for about five minutes of music.
- Slide the mode switch to **II**. Press the xylophone keys to "build a song." Each time you press, you hear part of a song. Press again to hear more.
- Slide the mode switch to **III**. Rock the toy for music or press the xylophone keys to hear individual notes.
- When you are finished playing with this toy, slide the mode switch off **O**.

Care

- Wipe this toy with a clean cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution. Do not immerse this toy.
- The xylophone has no consumer serviceable parts. Do not take the xylophone apart.
