Adult assembly is required.


Tool required for assembly: Phillips screwdriver (not included).

This product contains small parts in its unassembled state. Adult assembly is required.







#6 x 1/2" (1,3 cm) Screw - 4 #6 x 1" (2,54 cm) Screw - 4


Elevator




- Position the elevator on a flat surface. Note the locations of the bottom slots and the upper tabs on the elevator.
- Hold the base at an angle. While making sure the upper tabs on the elevator fit into the grooves in the base (1), insert the tabs on the base into the bottom slots on the elevator (3).
- Press down on the base to "snap" the lift in place.




- Fit the elevator roof on the elevator.
- Insert four #6 x 1" (2,54 cm) screws into the elevator roof and tighten.




- Turn the garage on its side on a flat surface, as shown.
- Fit the connectors on the end of the ramp into the holes on the top of the base. Be sure to fit the hooked tab on the side of the elevator into the slot on the ramp. Press the ramp until it "snaps" in place.
- Turn the garage upright again.




• "Snap" the tabs on the lower track into the slots in the base.




- Press the clamp on the track support onto the base column.
- Rotate the track support so that the holes in the support fit over the pegs on the lower track.




- Turn the garage on its side on a flat surface, as shown.
- "Snap" the rectangular connectors on the upper track into the holes at the top of the base.
- Fit the other end of the upper track over the end of the lower track.
- Turn the garage upright again.
- Insert two ½" (1,3 cm) screws into the holes on the underside of the upper track, as shown. Tighten the screws.




- Tip the elevator handle and fit the hooked tab through the channel in the side of the elevator **(A)**.
- Slide the elevator handle down and "snap" the tab on the handle into the slot in the elevator **3**.



• "Snap" the news stand into the top side of the base.




- Align the holes in the post with the pegs, as shown.
- \bullet Insert two ½" (1,3 cm) screws into the post and tighten.
- Turn the garage upright.



• "Snap" the gate into the slots on the top of the garage.



• "Snap" the vacuum into the base.




• "Snap" the tool chest into the base.




• Fasteners have been added to secure the figures to the package. The fasteners are not a toy. Wiggle and pull the fasteners to remove them. Throw them away immediately.



Battery Installation

- Locate the battery compartment on the top level of the garage.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door. Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three "AA" (LR6) alkaline batteries.

Hint: We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.

Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw.

Battery Safety Information
