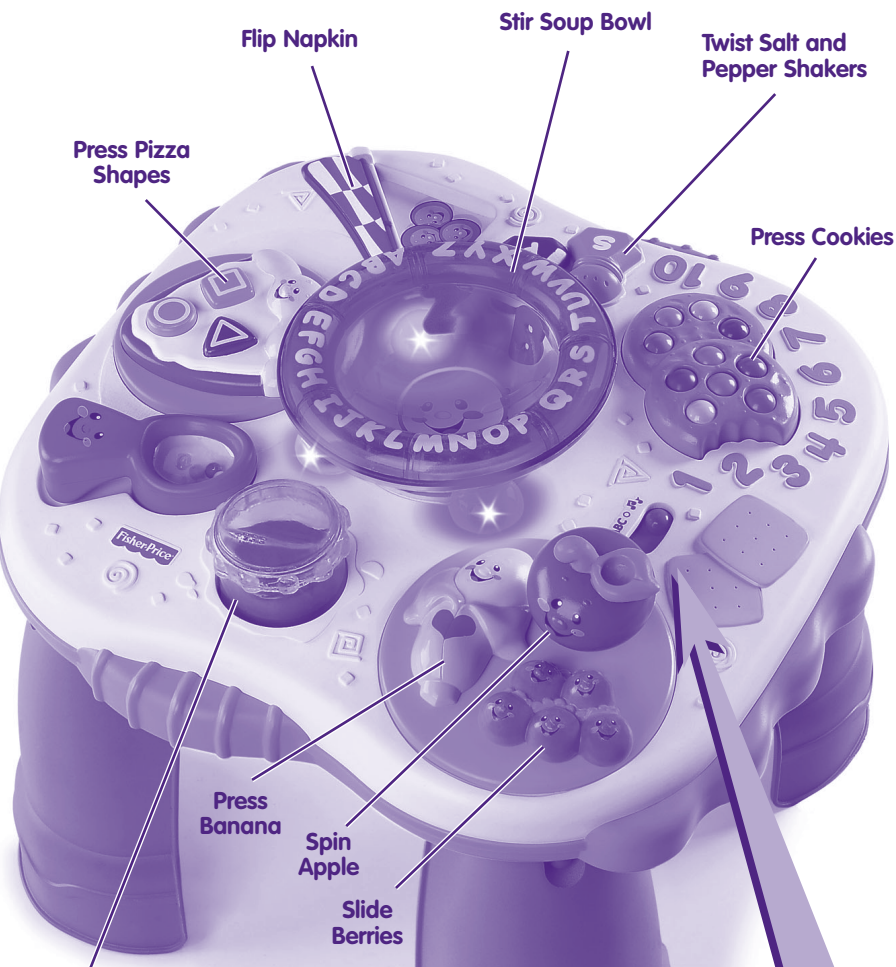


## 2. Music fun

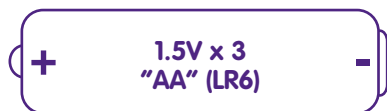

# Battery Replacement

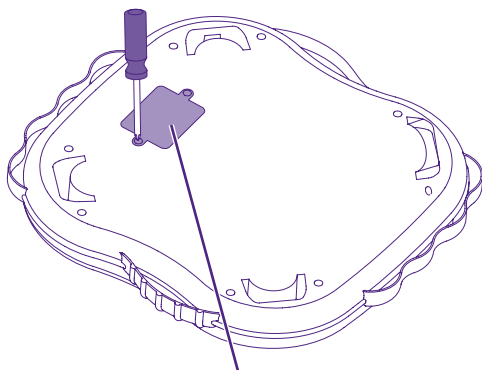


**Note:** We recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with three, new alkaline "AA" (LR6) batteries.

- Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the tabletop.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three "AA" (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.

**Hint:** We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- When lights or sounds from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!
- Protect the environment by not disposing of this product with household waste (2002/96/EC). Check your local authority for recycling advice and facilities (Europe only).



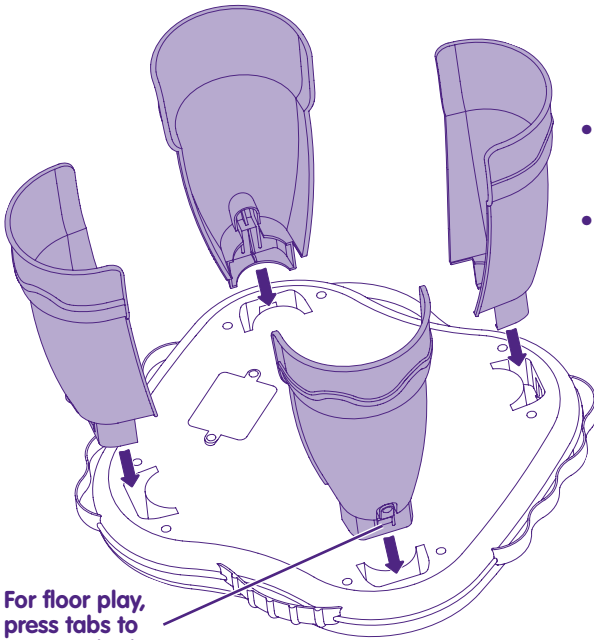
**Battery Compartment Door**

## Battery Safety Information

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

## Assembly



- Turn the tabletop upside down on a soft surface.
- Insert and “snap” the legs into the slots in the tabletop.
