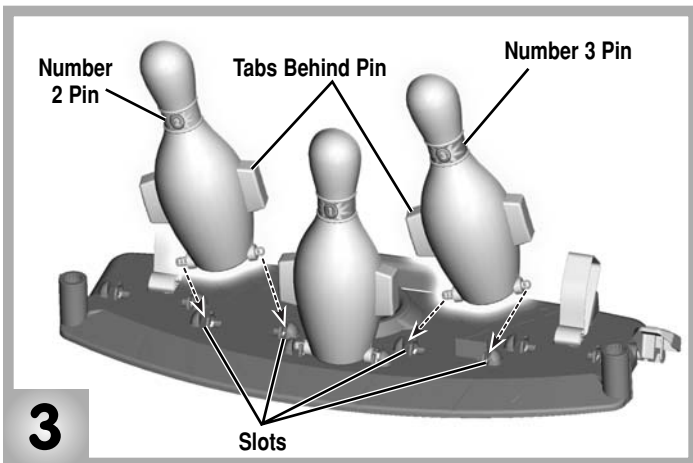
Assembly



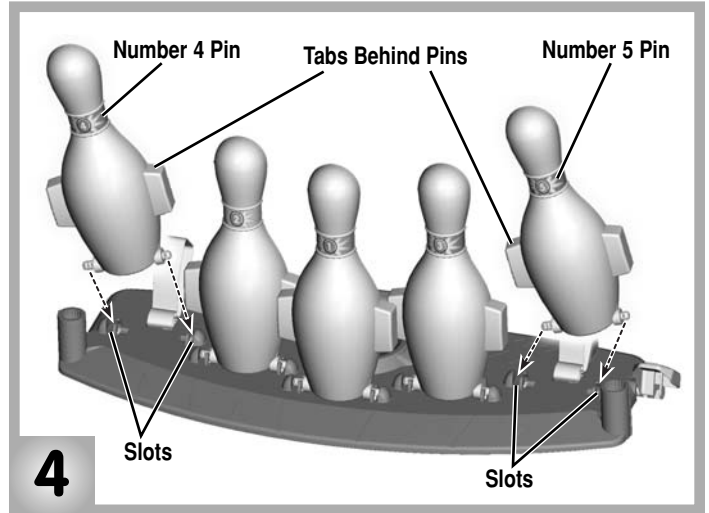
- Carefully peel a label from the label sheet and attach it to a pin, as shown.
- Smooth out the label to remove any air bubbles.
- Repeat this procedure to apply the remaining labels to the remaining bowling pins.



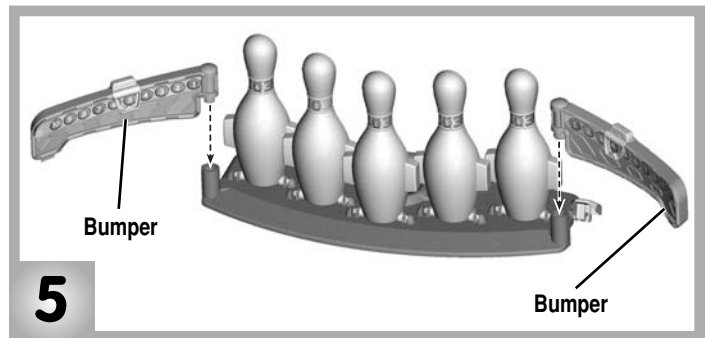
- At an angle, insert the longer peg on the number 1 pin into the groove at the front and center of the base.
- Push down on the other side of the pin to "snap" it in place.



- Position the number 2 pin and the number 3 pin next to the number 1 pin.
- While making sure the tabs on the number 2 and 3 pins are **behind** the number 1 pin, attach the pins using the same procedure in assembly step 2.

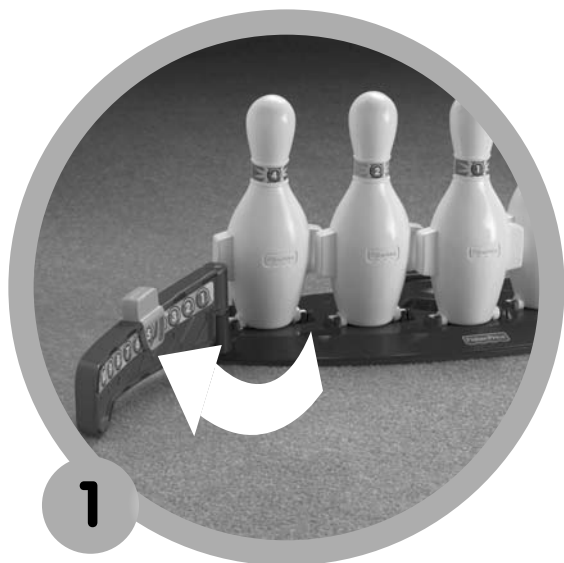


- Position the number 4 pin next to the number 2 pin and the number 5 pin next to the number 3 pin.
- While making sure the tabs on the number 4 and 5 pins are **behind** the number 2 and 3 pins, attach the pins using the same procedure in assembly step 2.

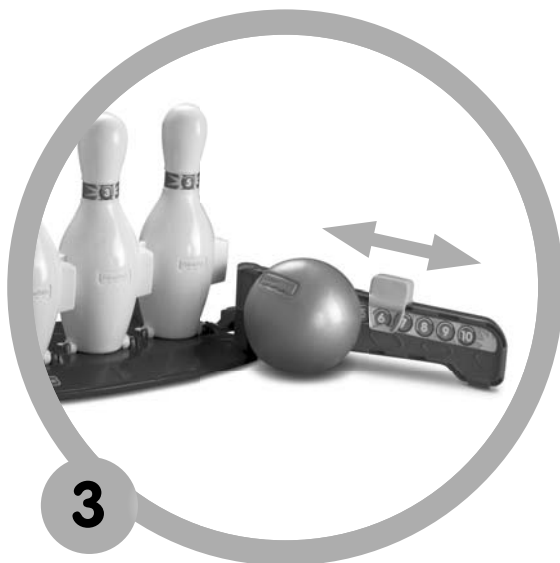


- "Snap" the bumpers into the holes on the sides of the base.
- Hint: If a bumper does not seem to fit on one side of the base, try assembling it to the other side of the base!*

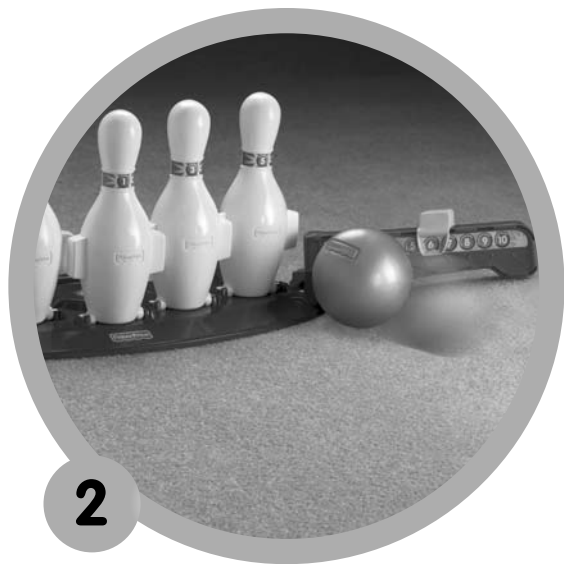
Set 'em Up and Knock 'em Down!



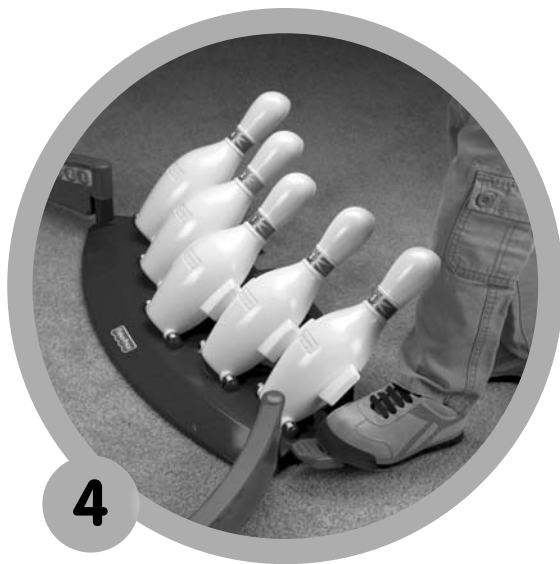
- Open the bumpers on the sides of the base.



- Slide the tab on the bumper to keep score!



- Roll the ball towards the pins.



- Push the lever behind the right bumper to set the pins up again.

Hint: The pins are designed to breakaway from the base. Simply re-attach them using the procedure in assembly step 2.
