Battery Replacement



For best performance, we recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with three, new "AA" (LR6) alkaline batteries.

- Locate the battery compartment on the back of the toy.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door. Remove the exhausted batteries and throw them away.
- Insert three, new "AA" (LR6)
 alkaline batteries.


Hint: We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- If the toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics.
 Slide the power/volume switch on the top of the toy off and then back on.
- If sounds or lights become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.

Battery Safety Information




In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the product before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- To clean, wipe the surface of this toy with a damp cloth. Do not immerse this toy.
- Do not drop this toy on a hard surface.
- This toy has no consumer serviceable parts. Please do not take this toy apart.

Crib Attachment

IMPORTANT! Always attach all provided fasteners (strings, straps, clamps, etc.) tightly to a crib or playpen according to the instructions. Check frequently. If you are attaching this toy to a crib side rail that can be lowered and raised, make sure the crib side rail is in the raised (locked) position whenever a child is in the crib.




- Tie the toy's upper ribbons to the top crib rail.
- Tie the toy's lower strings around a crib spindle.



Note: It is better to tie the ribbons in a knot than a bow, since a bow may be easily untied.

Crib Attachment



 If the distance between the toy and the mattress is less than 7 inches, lower the crib mattress.

Fun Music and Dancing Lights



Power/Volume Switch

 Locate the power/volume switch on the top of the toy. Slide the switch to the desired position: on with low volume (1); on with high volume (1) or off ().

Mode Switch

Locate the mode switch on the top of the toy. Slide the switch to Short Play or & Long Play.



Listen to fun music and dancing lights when baby taps the toys or spins the roller.

♣ Long Play

Baby's motion activates the music and lights for up to 10 minutes.
