

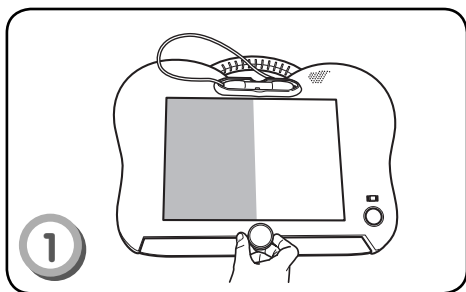

Requires two “AA” batteries (included) for operation.

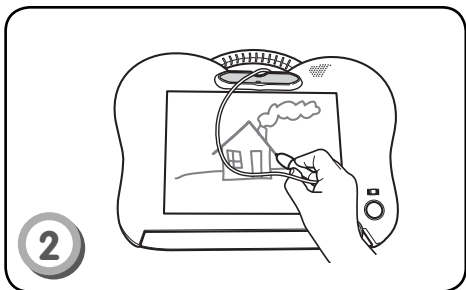
Adult assembly is required for battery replacement.

Tool required for battery replacement: Phillips screwdriver (not included).

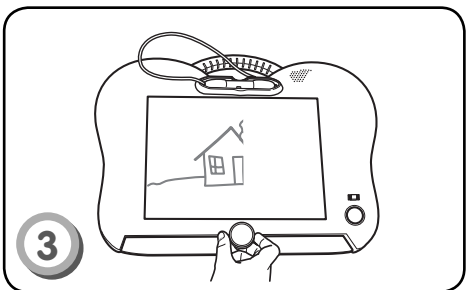


IMPORTANT! Before first-time use, completely darken the drawing screen with the drawing pen. Slide the eraser lever from side to side to clear the drawing screen. Repeat this procedure several times to enable the drawing screen to create the clearest, darkest images.

Drawing Fun!

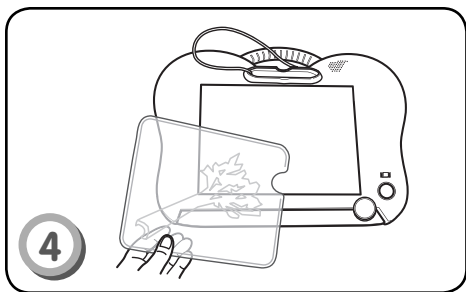


- Use the drawing pen to create your own drawings, play games or write messages.

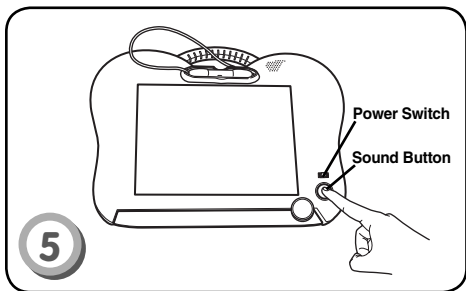


- To erase the drawing screen, slide the eraser lever slowly from side to side.

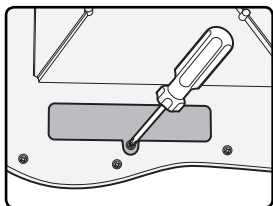
- Place a stencil on the screen and trace the image with the drawing pen.



- Slide the power/volume switch on the toy to on with low volume 🔊 ; on with high volume 🔊 or off ○.
- Press the sound button to hear fun phrases.

Battery Replacement

For best performance, we recommend that you replace batteries that came with this toy with two, new “AA” (LR6) alkaline batteries.



- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert two “AA” (LR6) **alkaline** batteries, as indicated inside the battery compartment.

Hint: We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw.
- If the toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power/volume switch on the toy off and then back on.
- When sounds become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!



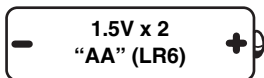

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Battery Safety Information



In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your toy.

To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the toy. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of the product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Care

- Use only the drawing pen included. Do not use any other object on the drawing screen.
