

Returning to Online Play

- Once you have completed installation, you can launch the Xtractaurs™ website anytime by connecting the Extraction Gun to your computer's USB port.
- Alternately, you may open your computer's web browser, go to www.XTRACTAURS.com and select "Sign In."

Tips & Troubleshooting

- After you have successfully installed the Xtractaurs™ program and registered online, you do not need to install the CD again to play. Keep the CD in case you need to reinstall at a later date.
- Make sure your computer has sounds enabled and speakers turned on to hear the game's sound effects.
- To see if the Extraction Gun is connected, look at the lights on the gun:
 - A slow, pulsing red light means it is successfully connected to your PC.
 - A fast, flashing green light means the program did not install. Reload the CD and repeat the steps under "Getting Started."

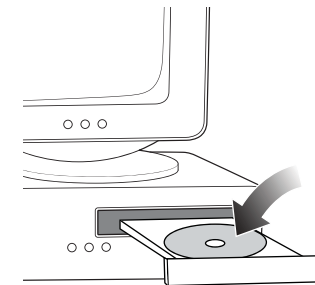

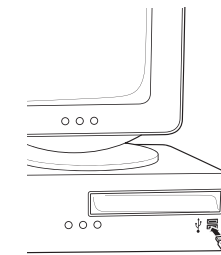
Getting Started

- Load the CD into your Mac or PC.
- On a PC, the program will auto install; on a Mac, select "RUN ME" to install.
- When prompted, connect the Extraction Gun to your computer's USB port.
- Once installation is complete, your web browser will open and you will be taken to www.XTRACTAURS.com.



Playing Online

- From the www.XTRACTAURS.com home page, click on "New Member."
- Follow the on-screen instructions to register and watch the tutorial to learn how to play.
- Extract "DNA" from your T.Rex figure (see below).
- To view instructions for each Training Game and Adventure Game, click on that game and select "Instructions."
- To exit the game at any time, simply close your web browser.



Extracting "DNA" Online

- Make sure your Extraction Gun is connected to your computer's USB port.
- Navigate to the **Command Center** online.
- Pull and hold the Extraction Gun trigger. Insert the plug into the jack in your Xtractaurs™ figure.
- When plug is inserted correctly, a DNA animation will appear on-screen.
- Once your dinosaur appears on-screen, release the trigger and remove the plug from the figure.
- Mix and match "DNA" in the **Hybrid Creator** to customize your Xtractaur™ !
