







INSTRUCTIONS


Please keep these instructions for future reference as they contain important information.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- Be sure the ON/OFF switch is in the ON position. The ON/OFF switch is located on the bottom of the car, next to the battery compartment (see battery diagram).
- Once the ON/OFF switch is in the ON position, the toy will perform its full play pattern as described below.

HOW TO PLAY

- Press the FORWARD button to make UmiCar count and drive forwards in a straight line.
- Press the BACKWARD button to make UmiCar count backwards and drive backwards in a circle.
- Press the CALL button to make UmiCar come to you.
- Be sure to hold the CALL button down until UmiCar circles, locates you, and then drives toward you. If you let go of the CALL button, he will not be able to find you.
- · Let go of the CALL button when he has reached you.



PARENTS' NOTE

- Works best on low pile rug or carpeting as opposed to shiny hard flat surfaces or plush carpeting.
- For best results, make sure the remote is no further than 5 feet away from UmiCar while playing. Be sure to point the remote directly at UmiCar with nothing in between UmiCar and the remote.
- If UmiCar does not respond properly to the remote, try playing in a different location. Certain locations may have interference.
- If engine does not respond to the remote controller, try dimming the lights in the room. Bright sunlight or fluorescent lights may affect the range of the remote controller.

BATTERY INSTALLATION

BATTERY INSTALLATION: (For Remote)
Unscrew and lift away cover from back of product.
Install battery as indicated inside the battery For longer life use only alkaline batteries.
