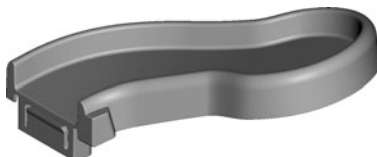

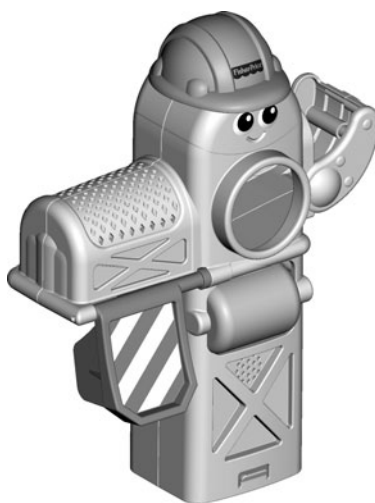

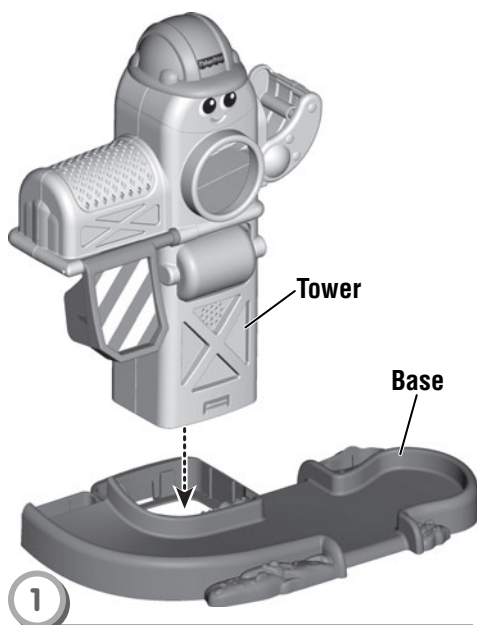

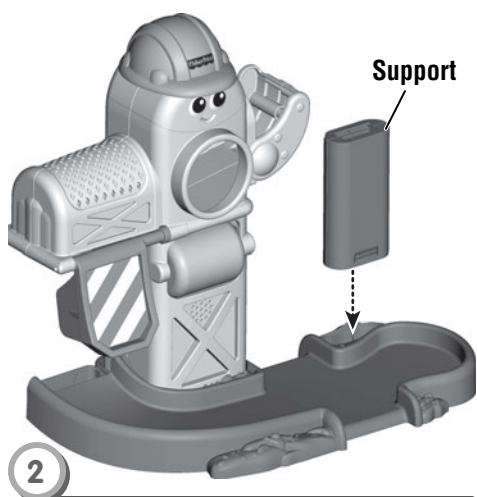

Assembly



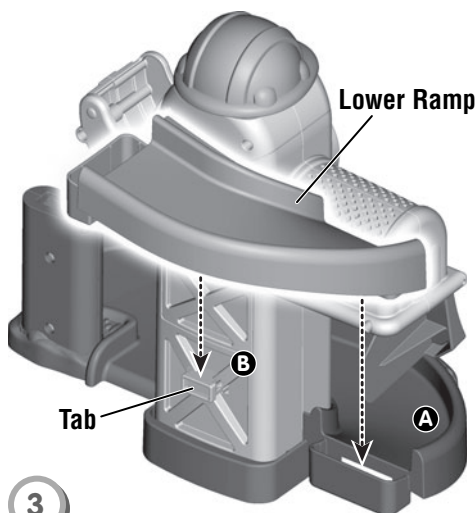
- Fit the tower into the base. Push to “**snap**” in place.

***Hint:** The tower is designed to fit into the base one way. If it does not seem to fit, turn it around and try again!*

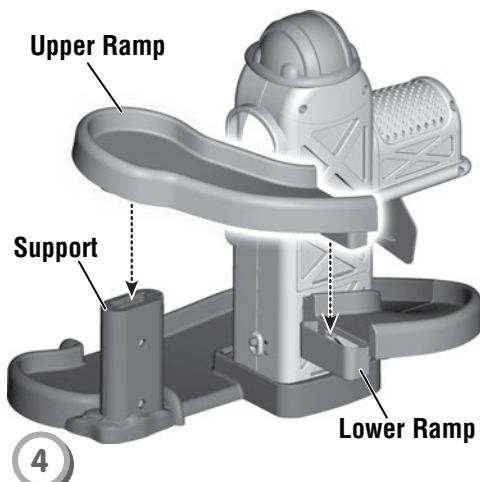


- Fit the support into the base. Push to “**snap**” in place.

***Hint:** The support is designed to fit into the base one way. If it does not seem to fit, turn it around and try again!*



- First, fit the tab on the end of the lower ramp into the slot in the base **A**.
- Then, slide the socket on the center of the ramp onto the tab on the back of the tower **B**.
- Push near each tab to “**snap**” in place.



- Fit the tab on each end of the upper ramp into the slot in the support and the lower ramp.
- Push near each tab to “**snap**” in place.

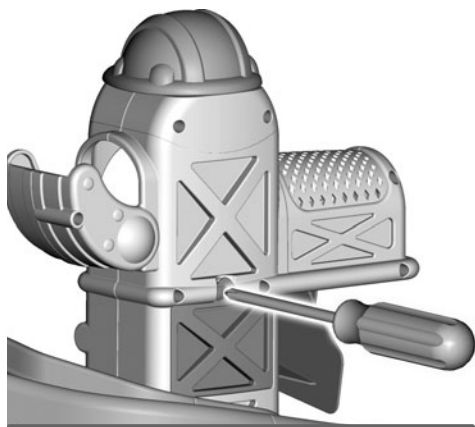
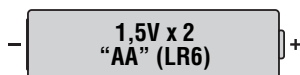

Battery Installation



- Locate the battery compartment door on the back of the tower.
 - Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the door.
 - Insert two, new “AA” (LR6) **alkaline** batteries into the battery compartment.
- Hint:** We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw. Do not over-tighten.
 - If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power switch off and then back on.
 - When sounds from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.



- Protect the environment by not disposing of this product with household waste (2002/96/EC). Check your local authority for recycling advice and facilities (Europe only).

Battery Safety Information

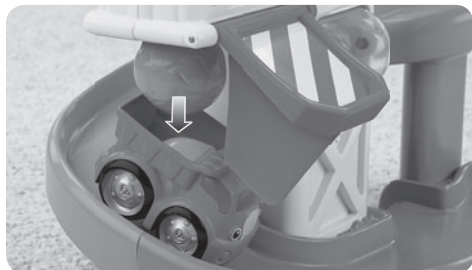
In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

- Slide the bulldozer down the ramp to “push” a boulder down the ramp.
