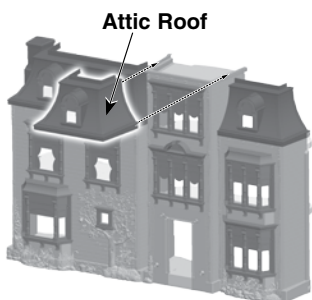

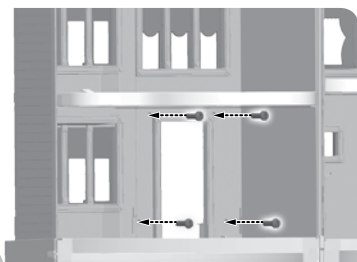

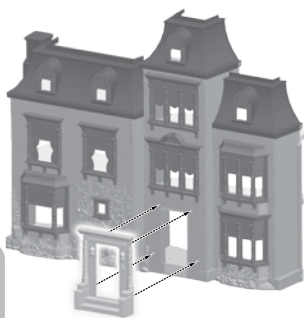
- Slide the attic roof onto the top of the dollhouse until it **"snaps"** in place.

BACK VIEW

- Insert four #6 x $\frac{3}{4}$ " screws into the holes and tighten with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.

- Fit the porch onto the front of the house.

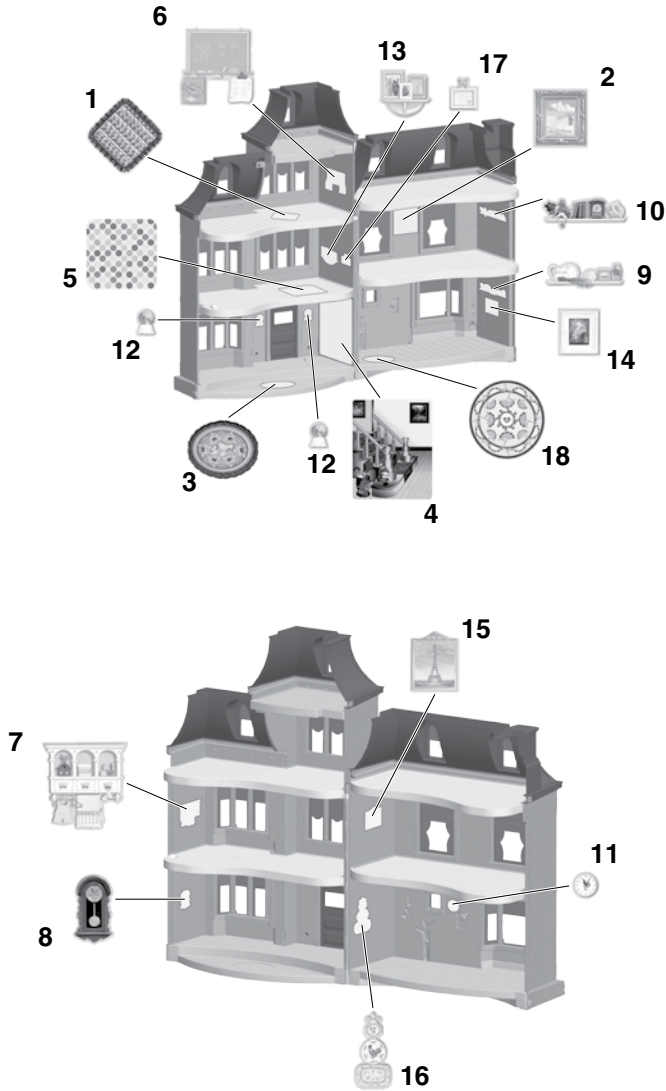

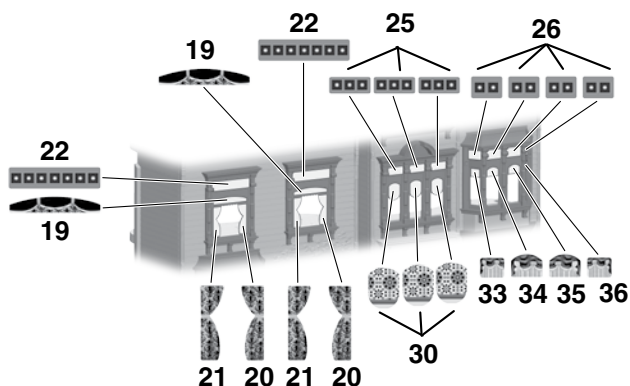
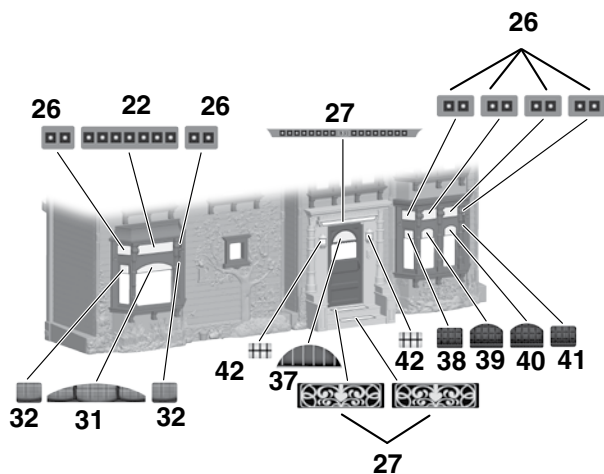
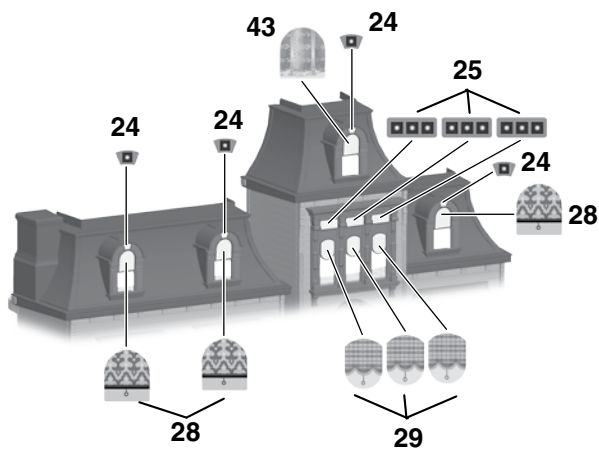
- At an angle, fit the peg on top of the door into the hole in the door-frame. Bend the door slightly and fit the bottom peg into the hole in the bottom of the doorframe.

Label Decoration

- Apply labels as shown in the illustrations.
- Apply the top corners of a label first and smooth downward to remove air bubbles.
- For best results, avoid repositioning a label once it has been applied.
- The label sheet also contains several extra labels you can place where ever you like.

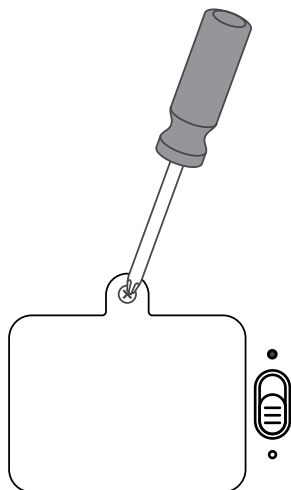
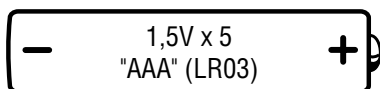


Label Decoration



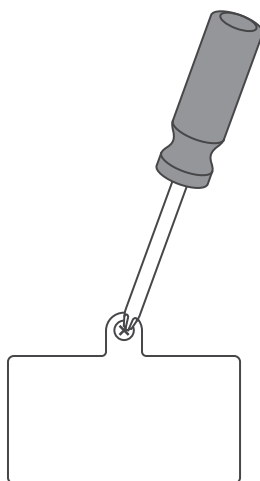
Battery Installation

When sounds or lights become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries. We recommend replacing the batteries with **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.



Tree

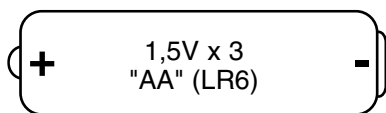
- Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the tree.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver and remove it.
- Insert three, new "AAA" (LR03) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw. Do not overtighten.
- If the tree begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power switch off and back on.



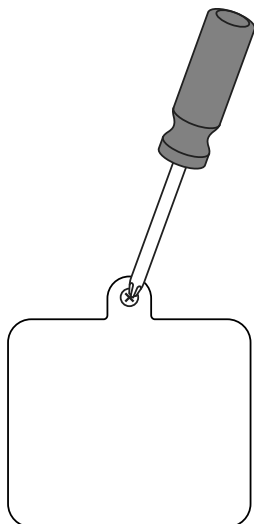
Stove

- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door and remove it.
- Insert two, new "AAA" (LR03) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw.
- If the stove begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Remove the batteries and replace them.

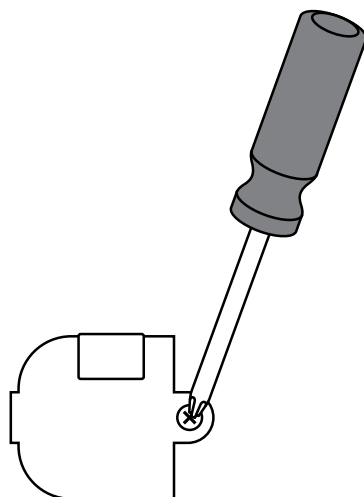

Fireplace

- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver and remove it.
- Insert three, new "AA" (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw.
- If the fireplace begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Remove the batteries and replace them.



Wreath

- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door and remove it.
- Remove the exhausted batteries and dispose of them properly.
- Insert three new LR44 **alkaline** button cell batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw.
- If the wreath begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Remove the batteries and replace them.

Battery Safety Information

Batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your toy. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated on the battery compartment door.
- Remove batteries during long period of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the toy. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same orequivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

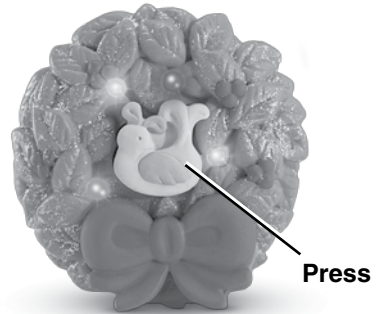

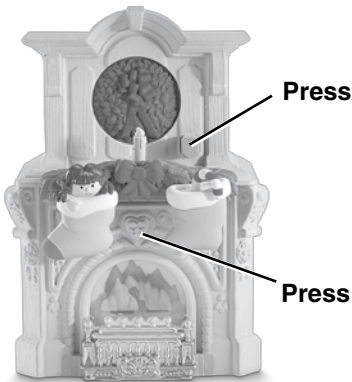
Fun Holiday Sounds

- Press the button for lights and sounds!

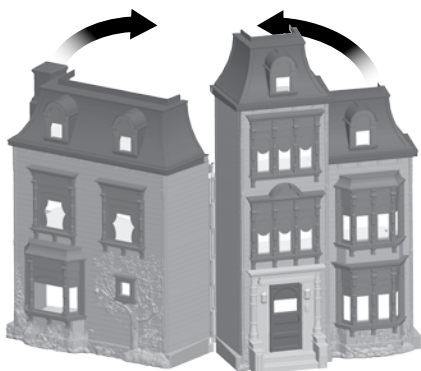


- Press the button on the mantle to turn the wreath and start the fire while you listen to fun tunes!
