



Batteries included are for demonstration purposes only. Adult assembly is required for battery replacement. Tool required: Phillips screwdriver (not included). Wipe this toy with a clean cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution. Do not immerse. This toy has no consumer serviceable parts. Do not take apart.

Battery Replacement



- For longer life, use alkaline batteries.
- Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the toy.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door and remove the door.
- Insert two AA (LR6) alkaline batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw.
- If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power switch off and back on.
- When sounds from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.

Battery Safety Information

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the product before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Look Out!



- Slide the power switch ON or OFF ○.
- Press the lever on the handle to hear sounds while the dragon lunges forward to "eat" a figure!
- Press the lever again and the dragon "spits" the figure out.



 Take the dragon to the Castle (sold separately and subject to availability) and it will recognize and respond to him!

Hints:

- The maximum response range between the Castle and this toy is 12 feet (3,7 m).
- Bright sunlight or fluorescent lights may affect the response range of the toy. Try dimming the light in the room you are playing in.
- Make sure you have a clear path between this toy and the Castle.
