

BATTERY INSTALLATION

Unscrew and lift cover away from the products.
Install batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
For longer life use only alkaline batteries.
Requires 3 'AAA' (LR03) batteries for James, 2 'AA' (LR03) batteries for Searchlight.
If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics.
Remove the batteries from the toy and replace it.

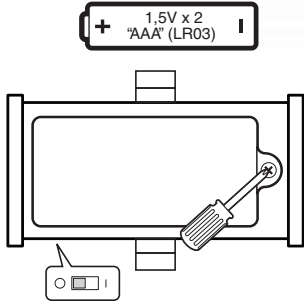
BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION

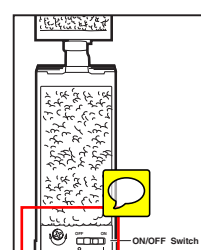
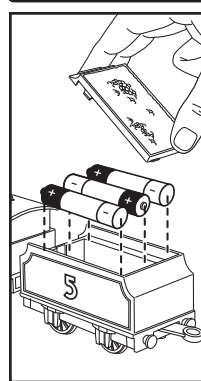

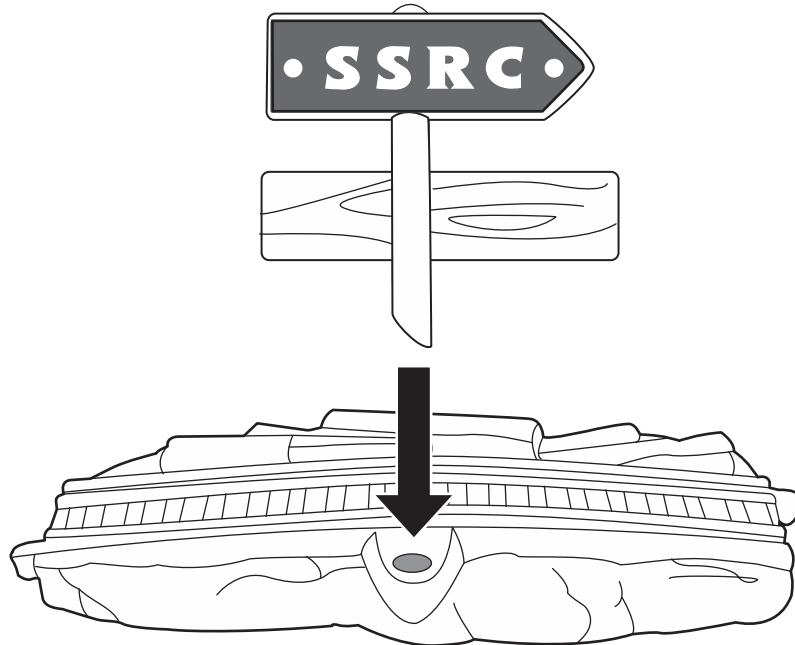

Sign Assembly

Insert the rotating sign into the slot, as shown.

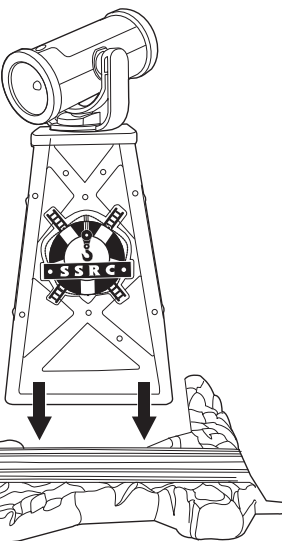

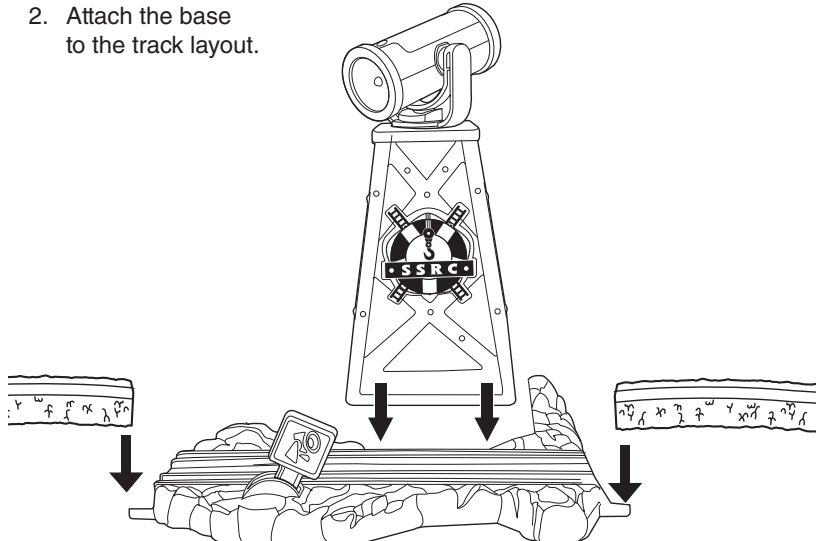
ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED. No tools required for assembly.

Searchlight Assembly

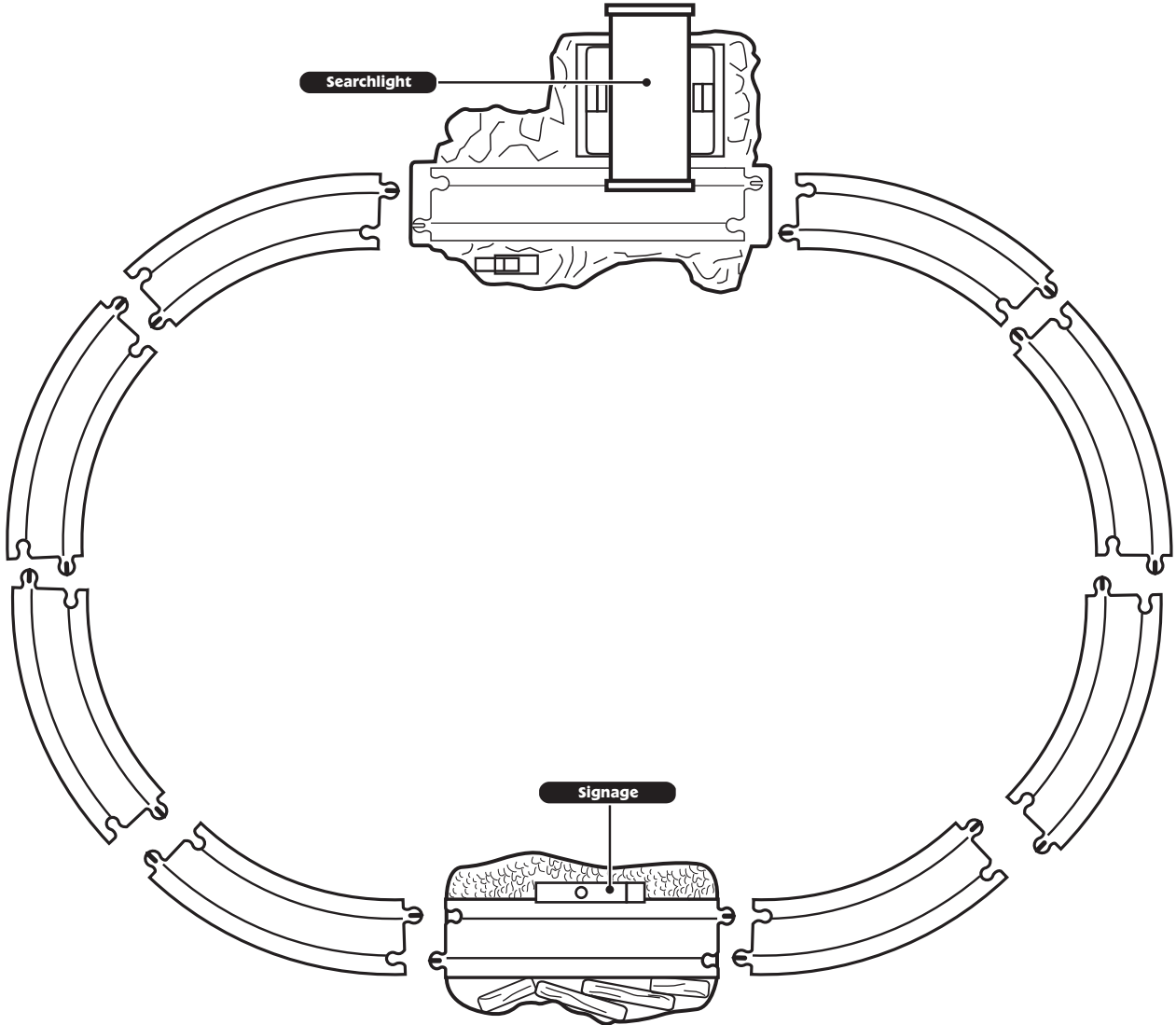
1. Attach the searchlight to the base, as shown. Once these pieces are snapped together, they cannot be taken apart.



2. Attach the base to the track layout.



Track Layout



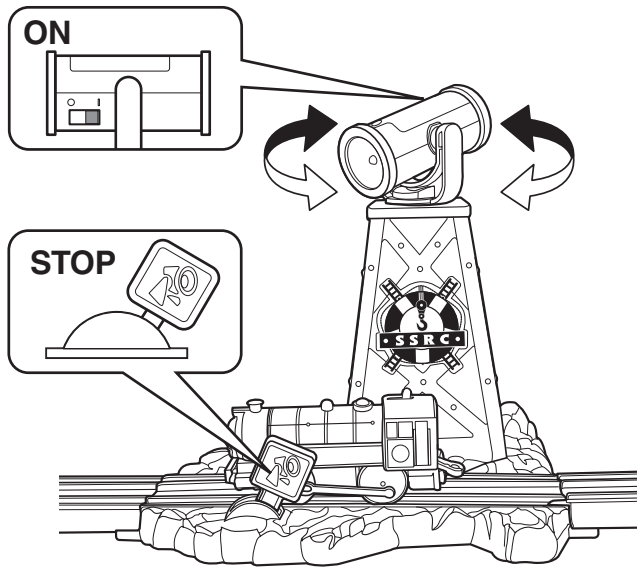
How To Play

1. Set the switch on top of the searchlight to the ON position to turn on the light.

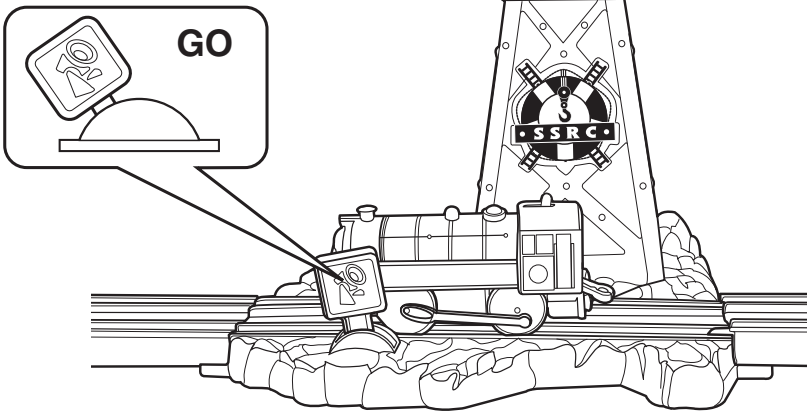
Attach the searchlight to any existing Trackmaster track layout (sold separately).

Set the brake lever to the STOP position. As the engine approaches, the brake switch will cause it to stop in front of the searchlight.

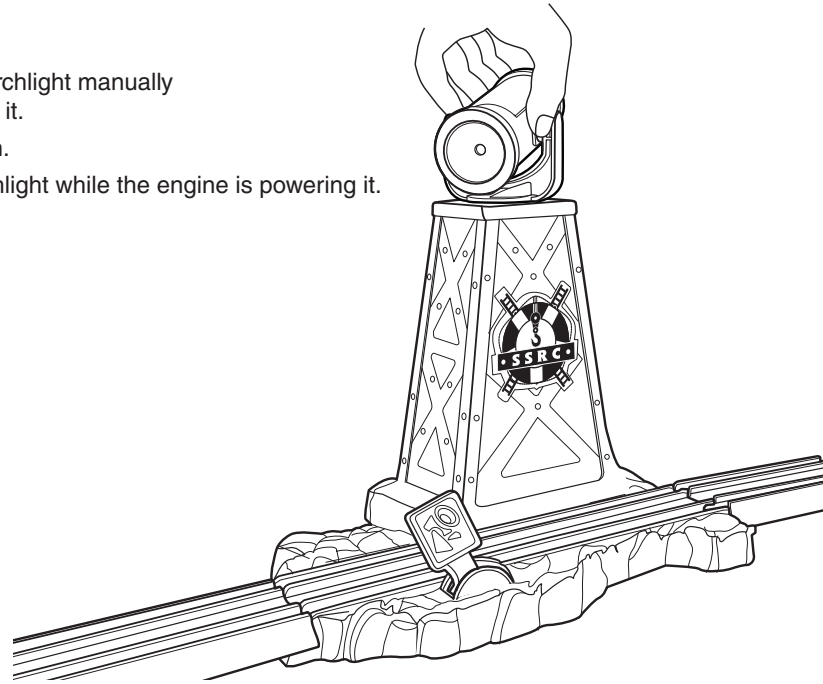
While the engine is stopped in front of the searchlight, the wheels of the engine will power the searchlight to spin around.



2. Set the brake lever to the GO position to send the engine on its way around the track.



3. You can point and shine the searchlight manually when the engine is not powering it. Set the switch to the GO position. Do not touch the spinning searchlight while the engine is powering it.



NOTE: Adults should remove & discard rubber bands holding tracks together.
