Requires 3 "AA" cell alkaline batteries (not included).

Colors and decorations may vary from those shown.

INSTALL BATTERIES

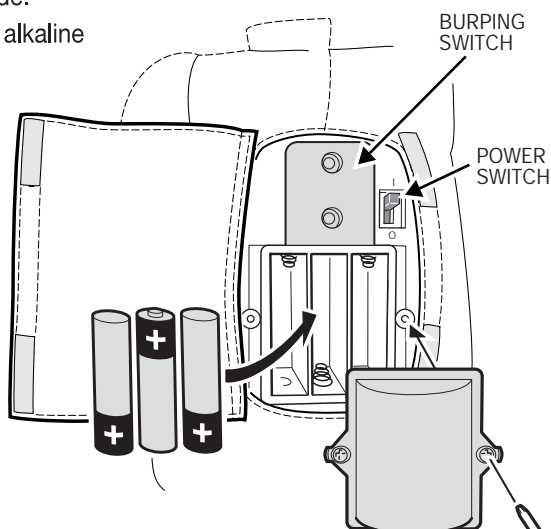
Open both sets of fabric fasteners on back of doll. Unscrew battery cover with a Phillips screwdriver (not included) and set aside.

Insert three "AA" cell alkaline batteries as shown. Replace cover.

USE ONLY ALKALINE BATTERIES:

Toy may not function or operate with other types of batteries.

When the product does not respond or the volume decreases, change the batteries.



BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION

1. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
2. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the product before they are charged.
3. If removable rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.
4. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
5. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries.
6. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
7. Be sure to insert batteries with the correct polarities and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions.
8. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the product.
9. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
10. Dispose of batteries safely.
11. Do not dispose of in fire as batteries may explode or leak.

SKIN CARE HINTS

- If skin is dirty, clean with warm (85°-100° F / 29°-37° C) water and dish washing detergent or with household alcohol.
- After cleaning, allow to dry at least 2-5 minutes before use.
- Talc can be applied to smooth the surface. (Use only a very small portion.)

DO NOT do the following:

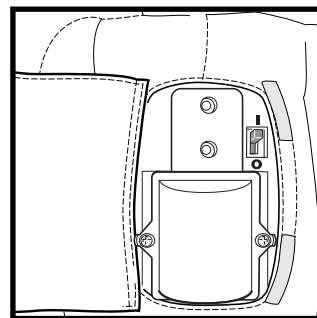
- Longtime exposure to direct sunlight.
- Apply excessive water to skin.
- Apply any type of ink.
- Apply nail polish.
- Clean with ammonia or any ammonia based detergents.
- Expose to high heat.
- Expose to sucrose-based or greasy food.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Please protect your baby's delicate skin from indentations, punctures or wrinkles. Keep her away from sharp objects, irregular surfaces and excessive heat. For instance, do not leave her out in the hot sun or inside a car on a hot day, and do not stuff her in a toy box.

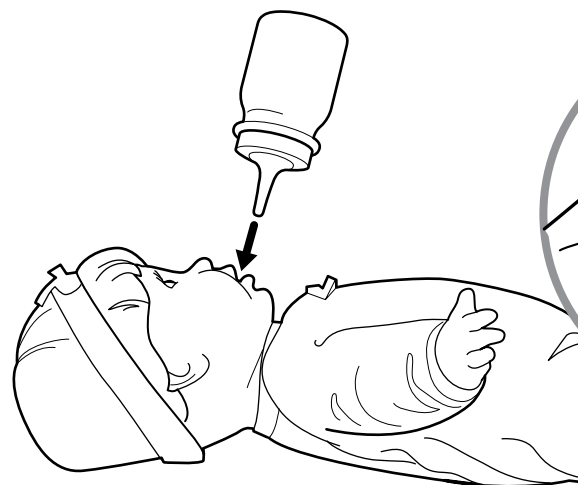
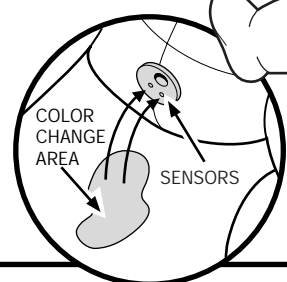
Water toys sometimes get messy. Protect play surface. After each use, drain, rinse, clean, and dry.

1 Move power switch to ON (I).



2 Put diaper on doll.

Make sure that diaper is attached to doll so that the change area makes contact with the sensor on doll's "bottom".



4 "Feed" doll.

Insert nipple all the way into doll's mouth. This will activate the feeding mechanism. "Feed" your doll with her bottle. Press the bottle into her mouth and squeeze the bottle. Do not overfeed, one bottle is enough.



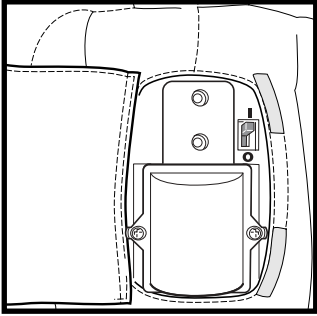

1 Move power switch to ON (I).



2 Put diaper on doll.

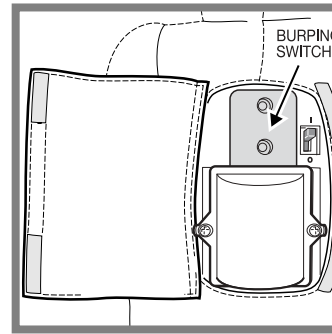
Make sure that diaper is securely attached to doll so that the color change area makes contact with sensor on doll's "bottom".



4 "Feed" doll.

Insert nipple all the way into doll's mouth in such a way that the tip goes into the hole located inside. This will activate sucking sounds.

"Feed" your doll with her bottle. Press bottle into her mouth and squeeze the bottle gently. Do not overfeed, one bottle is enough.



5 "Burp" doll.

When feeding time is over, you can burp your doll by placing her **upright** over you. Pat her repeatedly on her upper back (BURPING SWITCH) until she actually burps.

NOTE: After doll has been "fed", she will change her diaper when she is POSITIONED UPRIGHT.

Doll will fuss when she wets her diaper. It is time to change her diaper. See step 6.

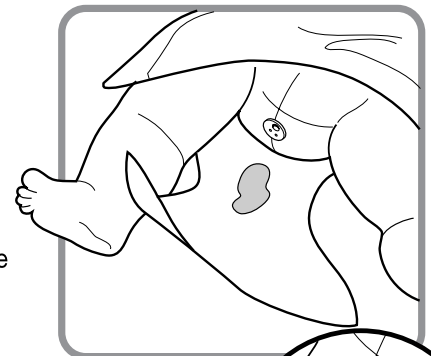
6 Change diaper.

Color-change area on the diaper will change color when the doll is wet. Open romper and remove diaper. Dry doll and sensor with wipe. Set aside the wet diaper to allow it to air dry.

Replace the wet diaper with the other color change diaper that came with the doll. Doll may not "recognize" that it is wet with any other diaper.

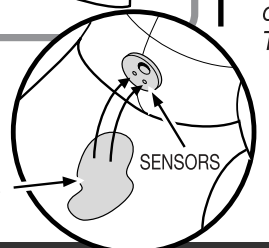
Once the diaper is changed, "baby" will "know" that it is dry and will make happy giggling sounds.

Color change will last longer if you do not expose this toy to intense heat or direct sunlight for prolonged periods of time.

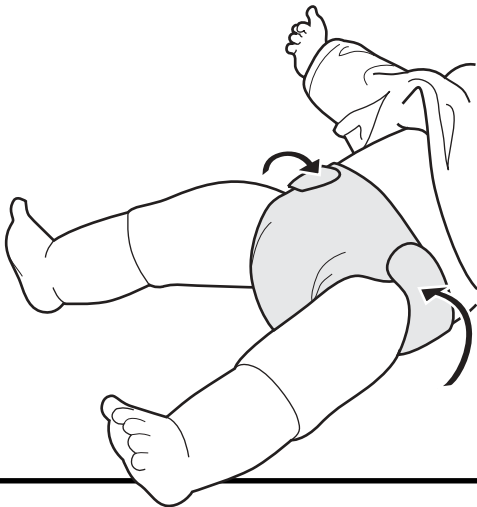
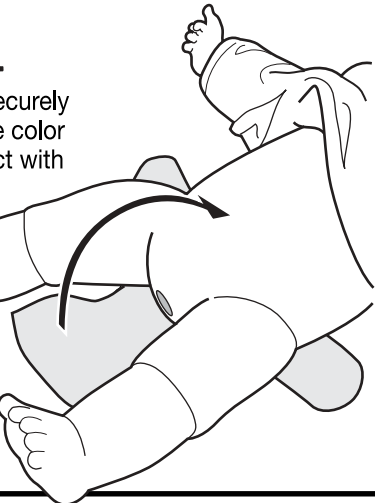

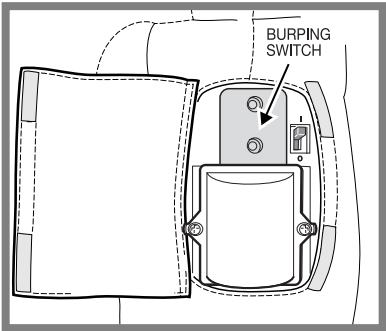


3 Fill doll's bottle with tap water.

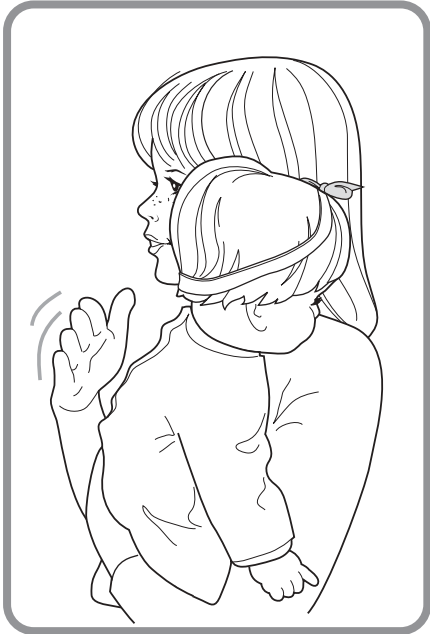

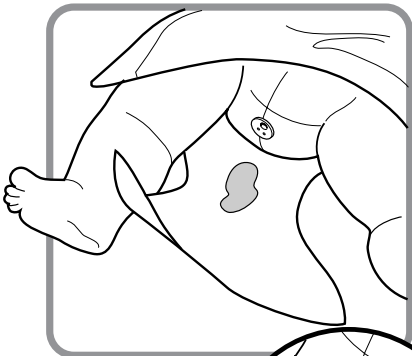
5 "Burp" doll.

When feeding time is over, you can "burp" the doll by placing her **upright** over your shoulder. Pat her repeatedly on her upper back (on the BURPING SWITCH) until she actually "burps"!

Doll will fuss when she wets her diaper. Then it is time to change her diaper. See step 6.



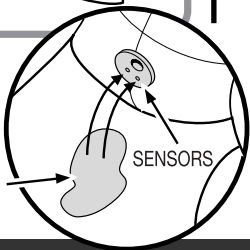

7 Lay your doll down.

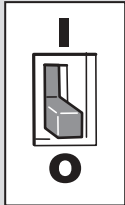
She'll drift off to "sleep"! Place your doll upright to "wake" her. Doll will make random sounds and eye movements without any physical interaction for approximately 3 minutes. After this, it will go into mechanical "sleep" mode.

During the "sleep" mode, the doll may open her eyes partially. This is normal.

Placing the doll in a vertical position, from horizontal, or "feeding" the doll will bring it out of "sleep" mode.



NOTE: When play is finished, it is important that you turn the power switch to OFF (O) while the doll's eyes are OPEN. If you leave the doll ON (I), the doll will go into a "sleep" mode. After a few minutes in this mode, the doll will slightly open its eyes. This is normal.

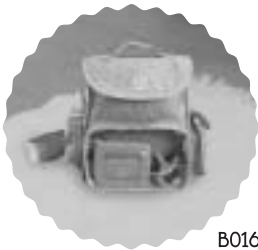

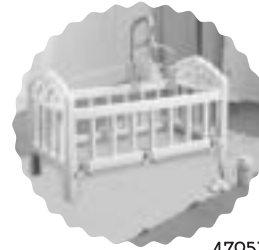
