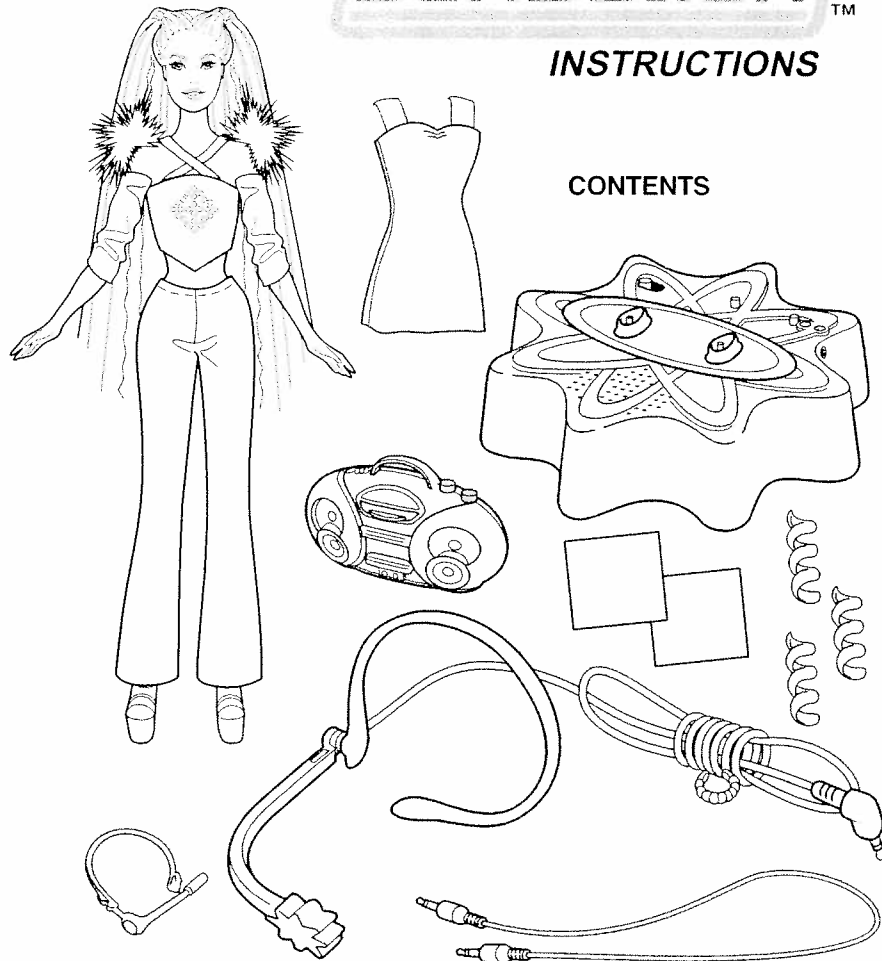

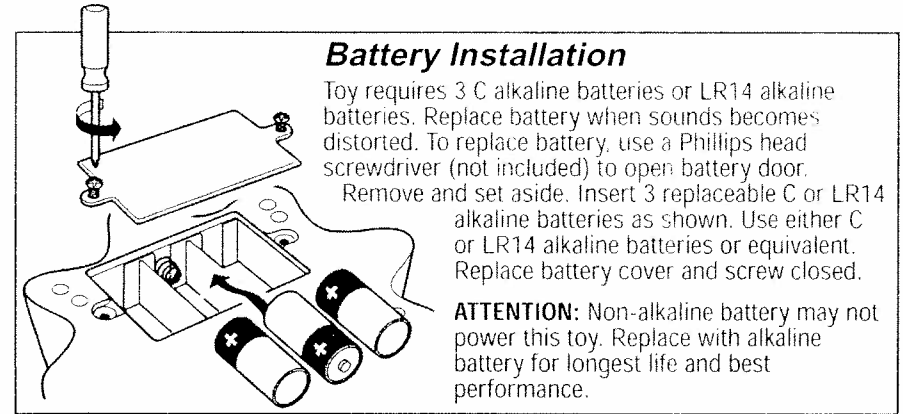

Battery Installation

Toy requires 3 C alkaline batteries or LR14 alkaline batteries. Replace battery when sounds becomes distorted. To replace battery, use a Phillips head screwdriver (not included) to open battery door.

Remove and set aside. Insert 3 replaceable C or LR14 alkaline batteries as shown. Use either C or LR14 alkaline batteries or equivalent. Replace battery cover and screw closed.

ATTENTION: Non-alkaline battery may not power this toy. Replace with alkaline battery for longest life and best performance.

BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION:

1. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
2. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
3. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
4. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
5. Do not mix old and new batteries
6. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
7. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
8. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
9. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
10. Dispose of batteries safely.
11. Do not dispose of in fire as batteries may explode or leak.

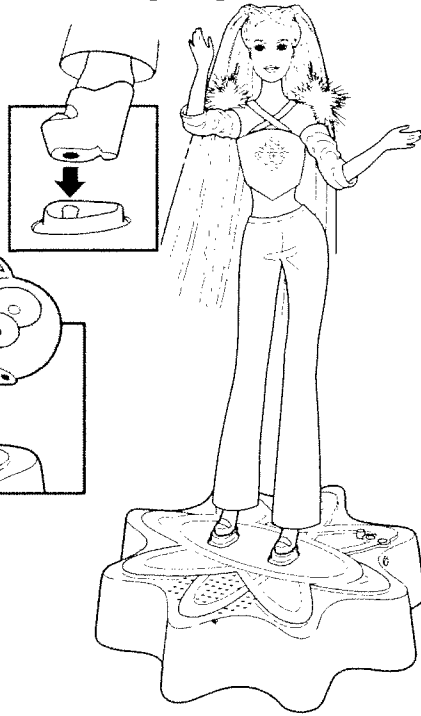

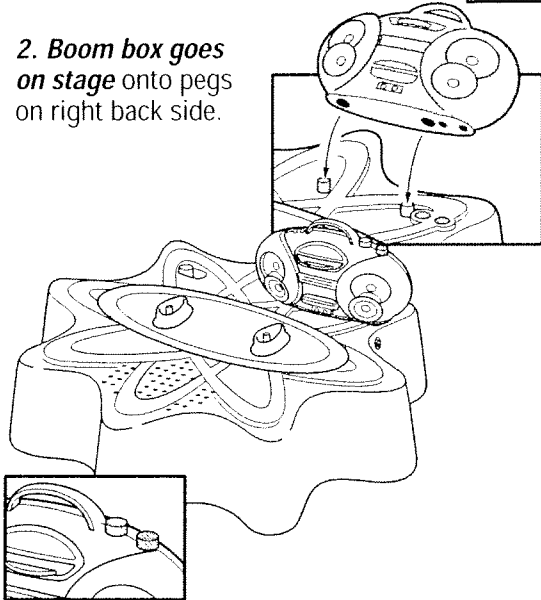

You and your doll are pop stars!

1. Place doll on to stage, with the shoe holes on the posts. Pose your doll.



2. Boom box goes on stage onto pegs on right back side.



Doll dances along with music.

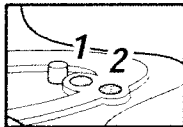
3. Boom box buttons activate the doll and the music.

Push the button #1 one time to play the music. The doll dances.

Push the button #1 two times and the music pauses.

Push the button #2 to change the song selection (2 songs are included).

Buttons on stage also work in case the boom box is lost. The boom box does not play music by itself.



On/Off/Volume:

Left position is off

Middle position is *low volume*

Right position is *high volume*



Plug in your own music, too!

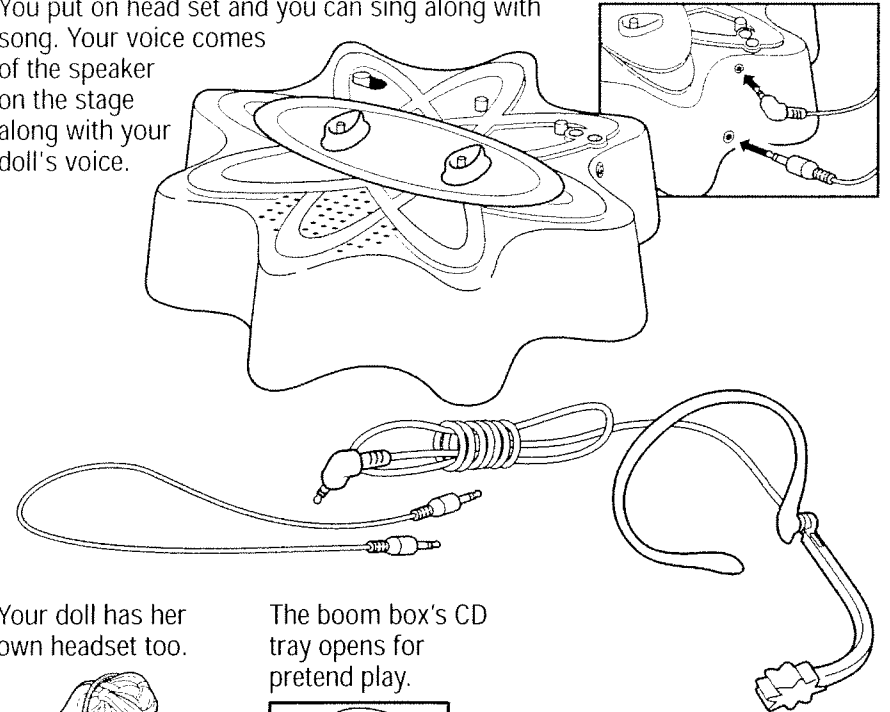
The *auxiliary cord* plugs into bottom hole on the stage and into your own music player.

This allows you to use songs other than what is included with toy.

Sing with your doll and hear your voice too.

The child sized head set plugs into top hole on stage side.

You put on head set and you can sing along with song. Your voice comes of the speaker along with your doll's voice.



Your doll has her own headset too.



The boom box's CD tray opens for pretend play.
