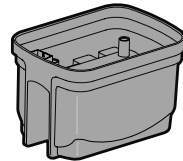

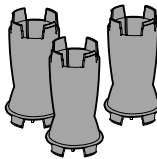

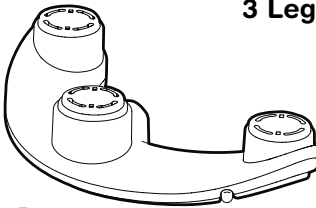
Seat Top



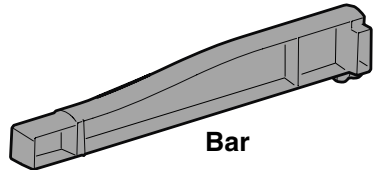

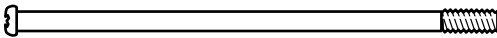

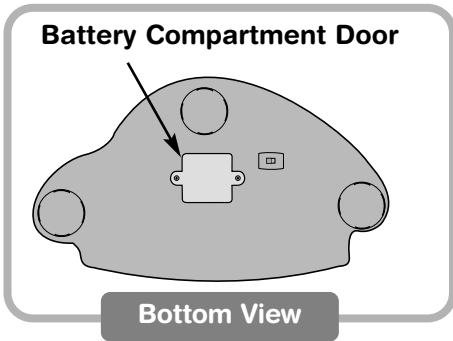
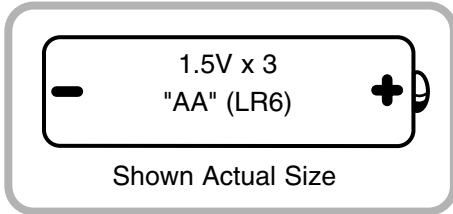
#6 x 2 1/2" Shoulder Screw

Battery Replacement

For best performance, we recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with three, new alkaline "AA" (LR6) batteries.



- Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the toy.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three "AA" (LR6) **alkaline** batteries, as indicated inside the battery compartment.

Hint: We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.

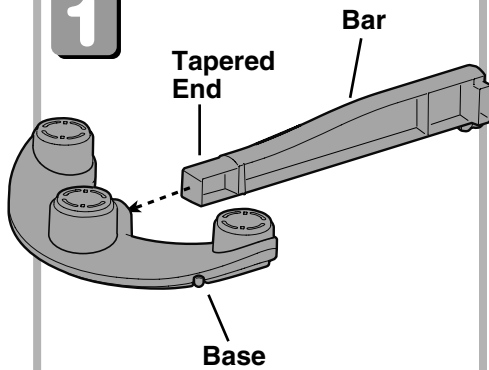
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- When sounds or lights from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!

Battery Tips

- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Remove the batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the toy. Battery leakage and corrosion can damage this toy. Dispose of batteries safely.
- Do not dispose of batteries in a fire. The batteries may explode or leak.
- Never short circuit the battery terminals.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended in the "Battery Replacement" instructions are to be used.
- If removable rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before they are charged.
- If you use a battery charger, it should be examined regularly for damage to the cord, plug, enclosure and other parts. Do not use a damaged battery charger until it has been properly repaired.

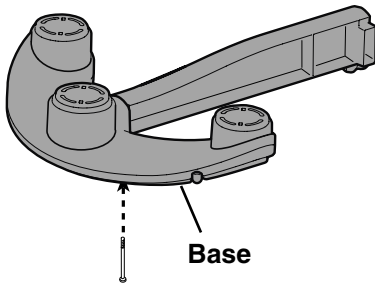
Assembly

- Place the base on a flat surface as shown.
- Insert the tapered end of the bar into the large opening in the base as shown.

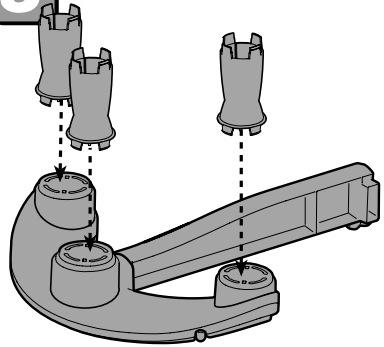

#6 x 2 1/2" Shoulder Screw
Shown Actual Size

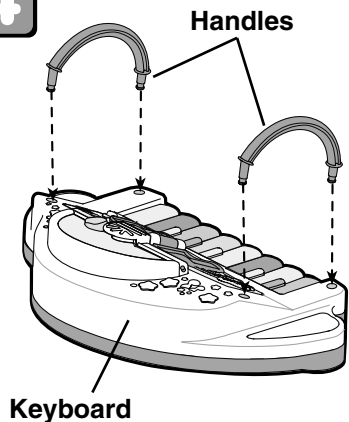
- Turn the assembly over and insert the #6 x 2 1/2" shoulder screw through the hole in the base and into the bar. Tighten the screw with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.

- Insert and "snap" the tabs on each of the three legs into the slots in the base as shown.

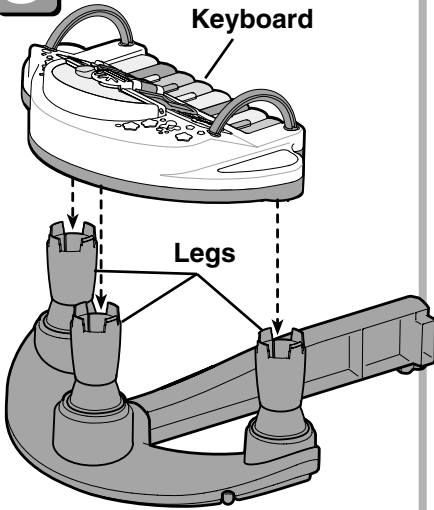

- Place the keyboard on a hard flat surface.
- Insert and "snap" the handles into the keyboard as shown.

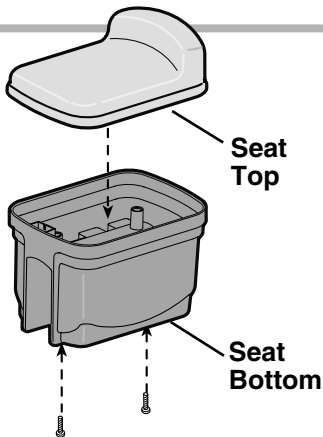

- Position the keyboard over the legs as shown.
- Press and "**snap**" the slots in the bottom of the keyboard onto the tabs on the legs.

- Fit the seat top onto the seat bottom as shown.

- Turn the seat assembly over and insert the two #6 x $\frac{3}{8}$ " screws through the holes in the seat bottom. Tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.

- Place the groove in seat bottom onto the bar as shown.

Note: *The seat will fit in two positions. Adjust the seat forward or back, to your child's comfort.*

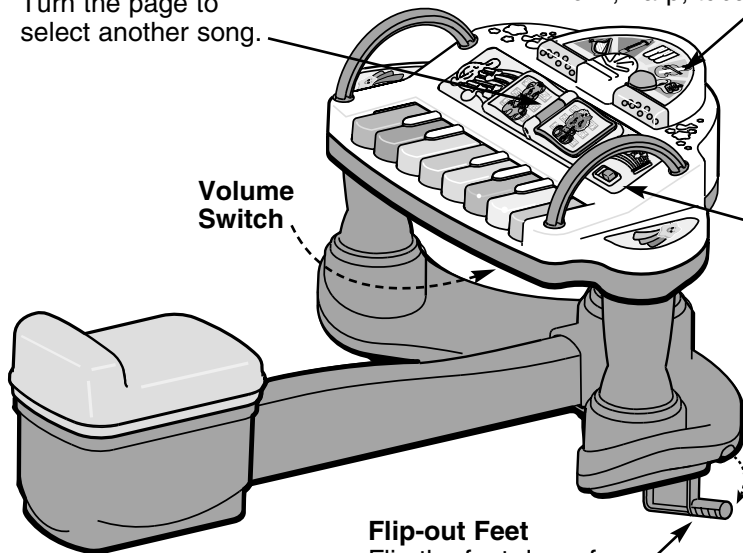

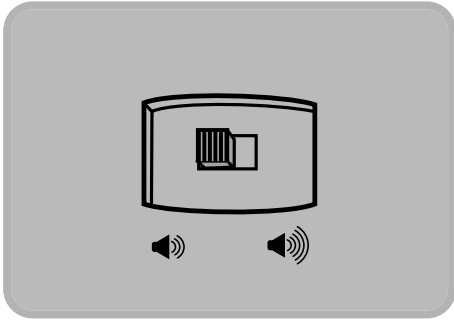




Flip-out Feet

stationary piano play.

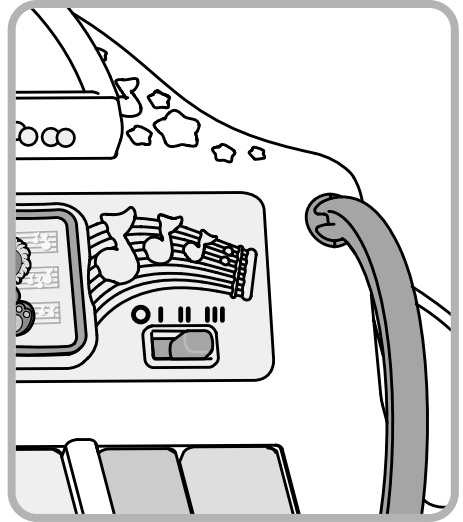

- Locate the volume switch on underside of the keyboard.
- Adjust volume to low  or high  for your child's comfort.

Mode Switch



The toy has three different ways to play.

I Rock & Play – When baby rocks the toy, a song will play with dancing lights. You can also hear a song by tapping a key.

II Build-a-Song – Press the keys or rock to hear part of a song. Press or rock again to hear more.

III Freeplay – Press the keys to play your own songs, just like a real piano.
