
Assembly




• "Snap" the ramp into the base.



• Fit the base onto the teacup ride as shown. Press down on the base to "**snap**" it in place.




- Turn the upper track face down. Fit the upper track support (larger) to the peg on the upper track.
- Turn the lower track face down. Fit the lower track support (smaller) to the peg on the lower track.
- Insert a screw into each track support and tighten with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.




- "Snap" the lower track into the base under the ramp (A).
- "Snap" the upper track into the end of the ramp B.
- "Snap" the upper track to the lower track **C**.

Battery Installation



- "Snap" the ticket booth and rocketship ride to the main assembly.
- Insert the flag into the top of the ticket booth or the hole in the upper track.



- Locate the battery compartment on the back of the ramp.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three "AA" (LR6) alkaline batteries.

Battery Compartment Door

Hint: We recommend using *alkaline* batteries for longer life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- When sounds from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.

Battery Safety Information

Batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your toy. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).




• Spin the teacup ride and hear a fun song.
