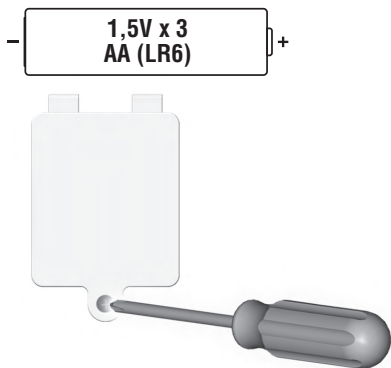
Required tool: Phillips screwdriver (not included).

## Battery Installation



- For longer life, use **alkaline** batteries.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door and remove the door.
- Insert three AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw. Do not overtighten.
- If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power/volume switch off and back on.
- When sounds or lights from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.



- Protect the environment by not disposing of this product with household waste (2002/96/EC). Check your local authority for recycling advice and facilities.

## Battery Safety Information

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.

## Crib Attachment



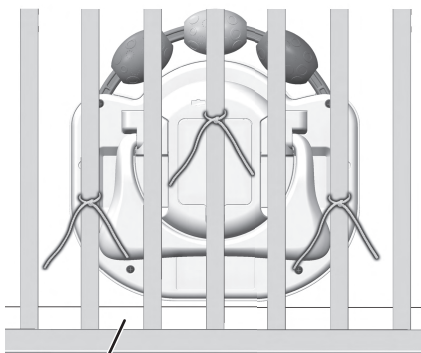
### WARNING

***Always attach with all provided fasteners tightly to a crib or playpen according to the instructions.***

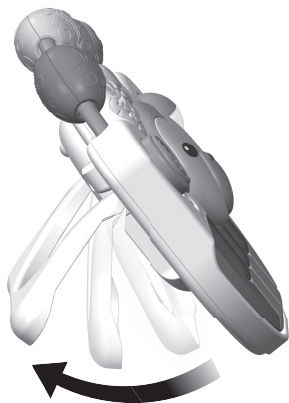
#### ***Check frequently.***

- Position the toy against the crib spindles/slats and with the bottom touching the crib mattress.

***Hint:*** For newborns, attach the toy to a crib side rail where baby can easily hear and see it. For infants, place the toy near baby's feet.

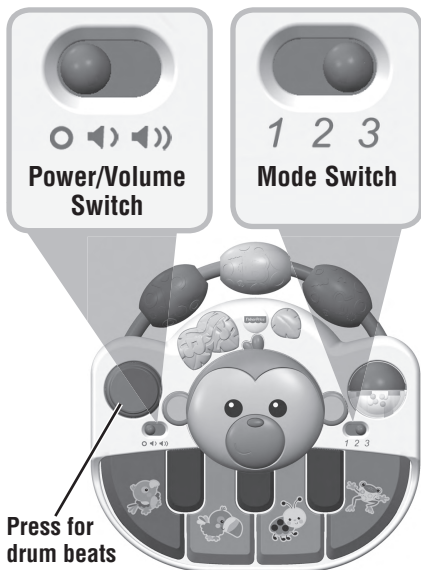
- Tie each string tightly around a crib spindle/slat. It is better to tie the strings in a knot rather than a bow, since a bow may be easily untied.

## Tummy Time



- Remove this toy from the crib. Open the kickstand for tummy time fun.

## Dancing Lights and Musical Fun!



- Slide the **power/volume switch** to ON with low volume ◀), ON with high volume ▶) or OFF ○.
- Slide the **mode switch** to:
  - 1 Piano Play** – Press each key for a musical note or musical ditty and lights.
  - 2 Animal Sounds** – Press each key for an animal sound or musical ditty and lights.
  - 3 Long Play** – Press a key for approximately five minutes of musical lights and music.
