# BATTERY INSTALLATION



For longer life, use **alkaline** batteries.



- Locate the battery compartment door on the back of the musical otter.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver and remove the door.
- Insert two, new AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw. Do not over-tighten.
- If the musical otter begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power-volume switch off and back on.
- When sounds or lights from the musical otter become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.



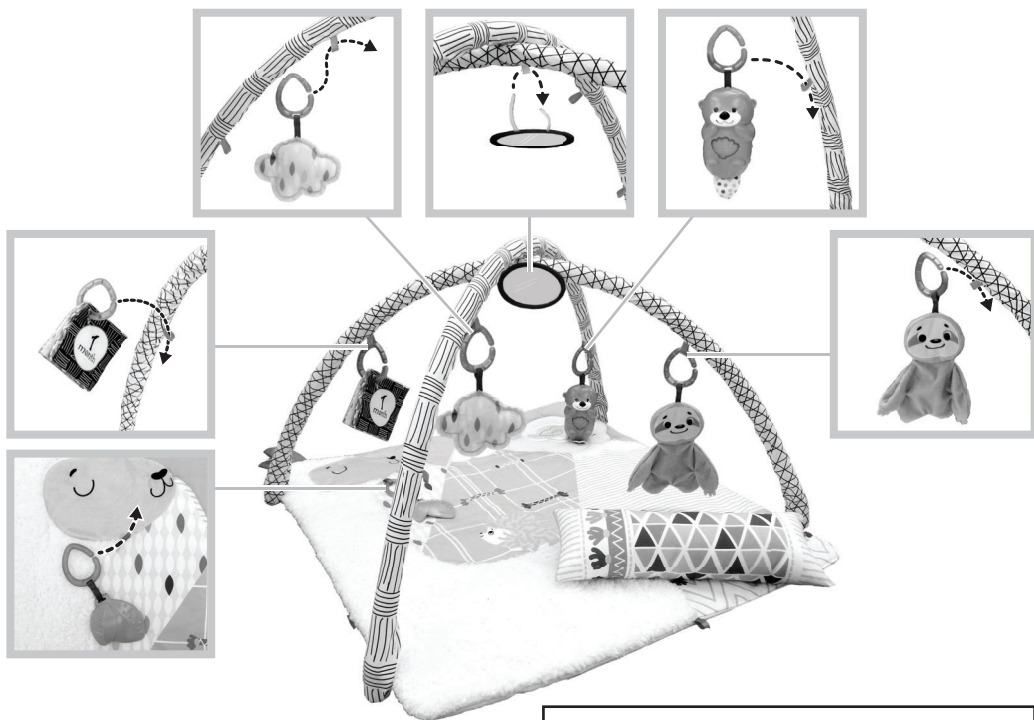

## Battery Safety Information

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Slide the mode switch on the musical otter to short play mode or long play mode.



- In **short play mode** , hear a short tune each time you press the tummy button on the musical otter.

- In **long play mode** , press the tummy button on the musical otter to start 15 minutes of continuous music.

Fold the sides of the month card inward that baby's age is facing outward.



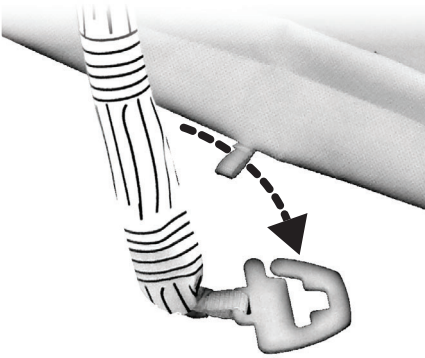

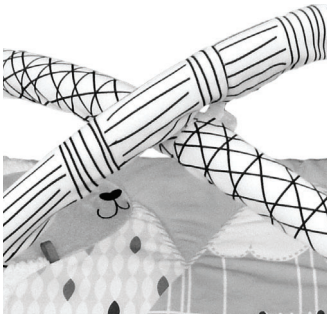

# CARE



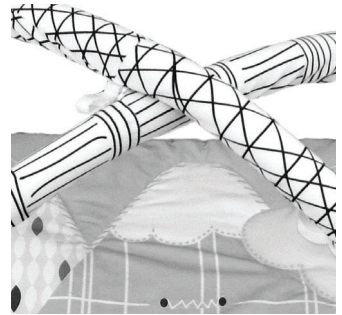
- The mat is machine washable without the arch assembly.
- While holding a mat loop, carefully unhook an arch clip. Repeat to unhook the remaining arch clips from the mat.
- Place the sloth toy and month card into a pillowcase and then into a washing machine along with the mat and tummy wedge. Use a mild detergent and cold water on the gentle cycle. Do not use bleach. Tumble dry on low heat.
- The arch assembly, musical otter, mirror, cloud toy, and leaf teether are surface washable only. Wipe with a clean cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution. Do not immerse.
