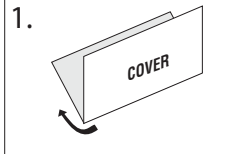

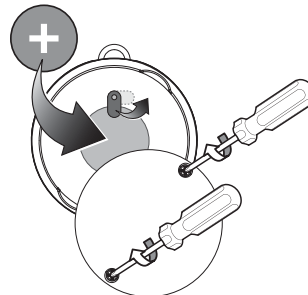

HOW TO REPLACE BATTERIES

The proper procedure for installing and replacing the battery is located on the downloaded instructions file @ www.puppytweet.com.

Requires 1 - 3V Lithium Battery type: CR2032 (included). Dispose of batteries safely.
