Consumer Information

- Please keep this instruction sheet for future reference, as it contains important information.
- Requires four “C” (LR14) **alkaline** batteries (not included).
- Adult assembly is required for battery installation.
- Tool required for battery installation: Phillips screwdriver (not included).

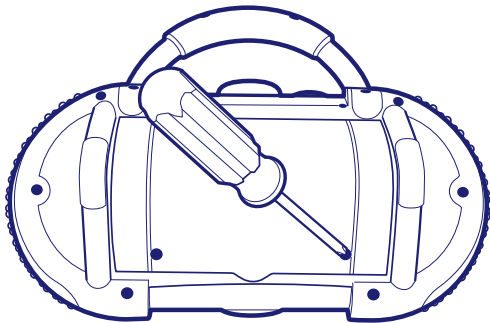

Care

- Keep water, sand and dirt off of the speakers.
- Keep the speakers away from direct sunlight and excessive heat.
- Wipe the speakers with a soft, clean cloth. Do not immerse this toy.
- This product has no consumer serviceable parts. Please do not take this toy apart.
- Do not drop the speakers on a hard surface.

Battery Installation



- Locate the battery compartment door on back of the toy.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert four "C" (LR14) **alkaline** batteries.

Hint: We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw. Do not over-tighten.
- When sounds become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.

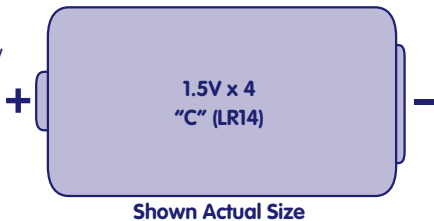


- Protect the environment by not disposing of this product with household waste (2002/96/EC). Check your local authority for recycling advice and facilities (Europe only).

Battery Safety Information

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your toy. To avoid battery leakage:

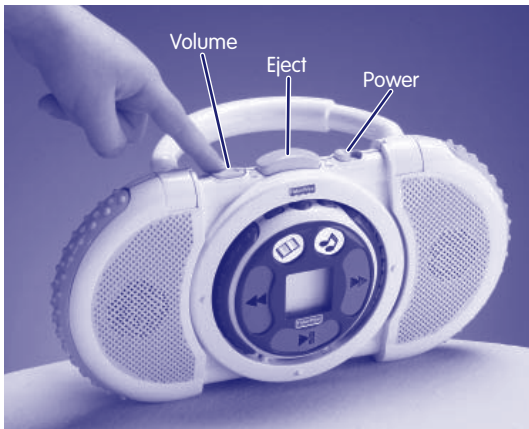
- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the toy. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.
