BATTERY INSTALLATION

- Unscrew the battery cover with a Phillips head screwdriver (not included).
- Remove batteries included for demonstration purposes and dispose of them safely.
- Install 3 new 'AAA' (LR03) batteries in the orientation (+/-) shown.
- Replace battery cover and tighten screw.
- For best performance, use only alkaline batteries.
- Replace the batteries if sounds distort or lights dim.
- If vehicle malfunctions, please turn the vehicle's power OFF and ON again. This should reset your vehicle and let you resume normal operation.



BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION

In exceptional circumstances batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.

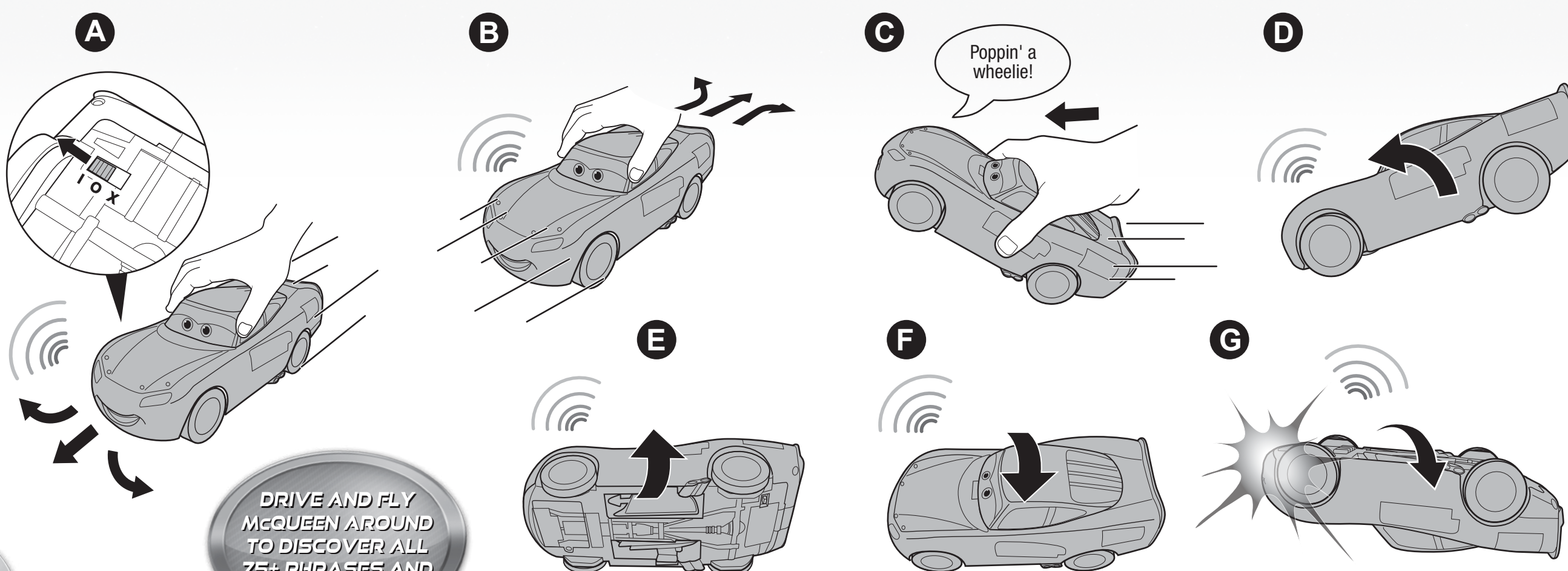

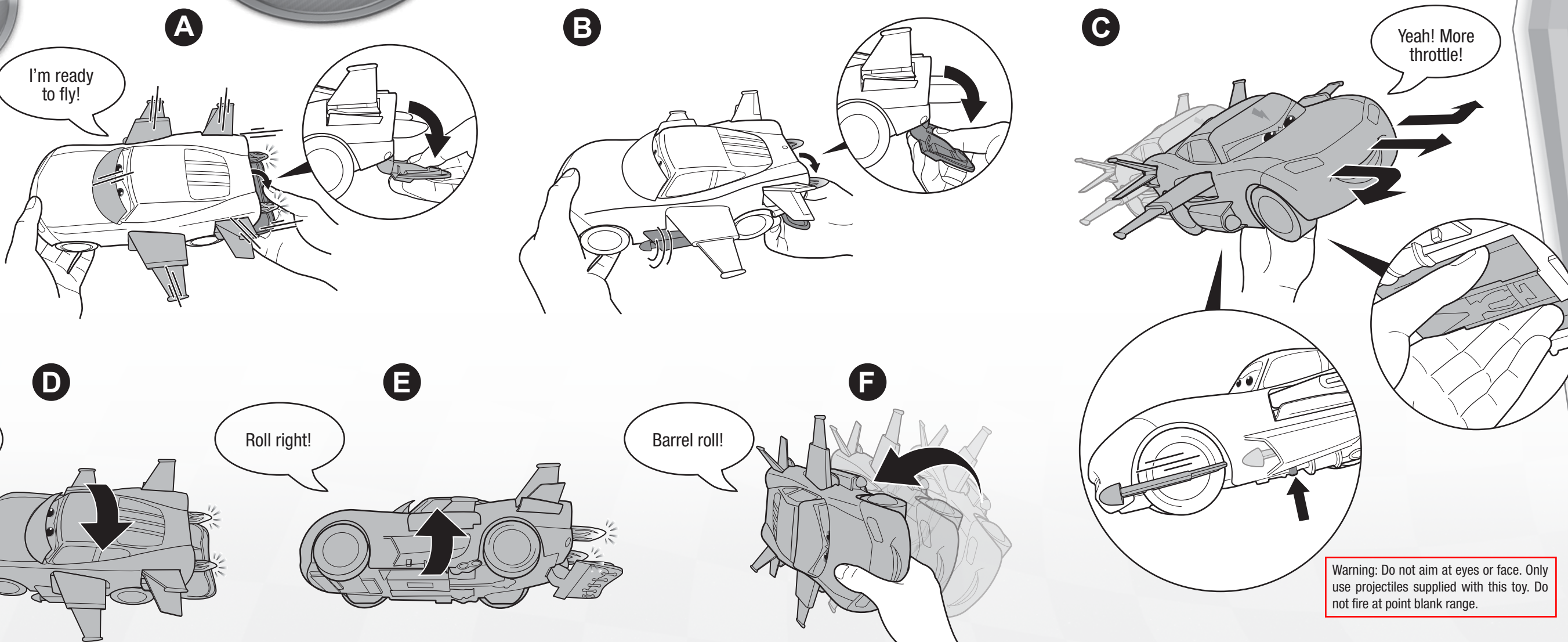
